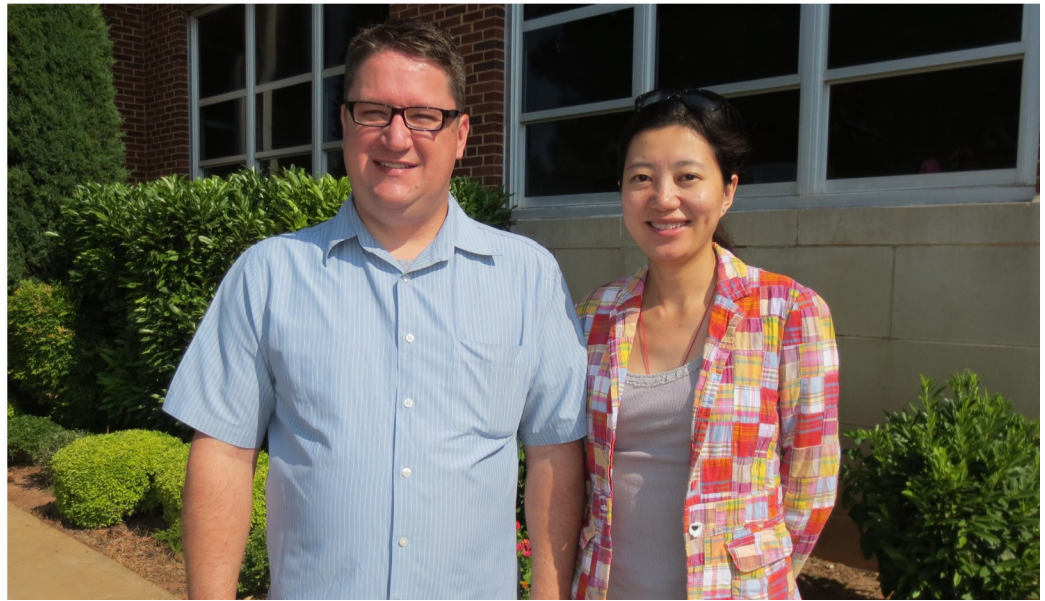

## “ACROSS THE DIVIDE” EXHIBITION

From now through February 6, Southwestern Oklahoma State University will be hosting a special exhibition titled “Across the Divide.” This exhibition will be open every weekday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. in the Art Building Gallery.

The “Across the Divide” exhibition features the artwork of a group of Chinese artists, all who received their graduate education in the United States and now teach studio art in universities across the country. These artists have used experiences from China and America to inspire their artistic creativity and their teaching methods in the classroom. This exhibition will offer a taste of their cross-cultural experiences to the public.



A symposium to accompany the exhibition

will also be offered. From 9 to 10 a.m. on January 15th, Mr. Yu Ji will give a lecture in the Art Building, Room 405. A panel discussion led by Mr. Ji and Dr. Shaoqian Zhang will take place that afternoon from 3 to 4:30 p.m. at the same location.

This event is funded by the Oklahoma Humanities Council (OHC). Ms. Xiaomiao Wang and Mr. Todd Parker, Assistant Professors in the Department of Art, Communication, and Theatre, received a grant in the amount \$5,000 to fund this event. OHC is the state affiliate of the National Endowment for the Humanities. The mission of OHC is to promote meaningful public engagement with the humanities disciplines, such as history, literature, philosophy, and ethics.
