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**ALUMNI SURVEY
UNIVERSITY REPORT
(Associate's, Bachelor's, and Master's Degrees)**

Program review and other institutional studies depend on alumni research for information about what happens to students after graduation. Decisions at Southwestern concerning curriculum, academic support, and student services are influenced by analyses of data collected from former students.

In May 2008, 4,370 surveys were mailed to 2002 - 2007 graduates of both Weatherford and Sayre campuses. Returns numbered 543, yielding a rate of 12.43 %. The 2003 response rate was 16.25%.

Few differences in data were noted when a comparison was made between the 2008 survey and 2003 surveys. Some of the 2008 response percentages follow:

- Alumni were asked about education, degrees, etc., that they had obtained after graduation. Forty percent responded that they had done further study, mostly toward Certification, Graduate Courses, and Licensure. The prevailing reasons cited for further study were "career advancement" and "state law."
- Less than five percent of respondents are currently not employed. Almost 70% are employed in the area that they studied at Southwestern, and 95% still use the knowledge and skills gained in their area.
- Seven percent of the respondents reported that if they had it to do over, they would take additional courses related to Business

Management; five percent desired more Accounting knowledge; and, Spanish was selected by almost five percent.

- No significant differences in "who advises" were found in comparisons of this and past surveys (1989, 1993, 1998, 2003). Faculty in the students' major areas served as academic advisors to approximately 58% of the respondents. The "self-advised" approximated 24%.
- Close to 62% were members of a club and/or social organization while at Southwestern. However, only 25% are currently members of the Southwestern Alumni Association.
- Ninety-seven percent of Southwestern graduates reported that they considered their investment in the university to be worthwhile.
- Views of academic quality ranked 1.75 on a scale of 1 to 5, with 1 being a "high" satisfaction level. Alumni respondents are mostly satisfied with both education (1.46) and faculty (1.46) in major area, and the quality of overall education received a score of 1.59. Grading standards rated at 1.77. Most services were well received; assistance with job placement improved from a 3.41 to 2.93.
- Demographic points of interest follow:

Ninety-nine percent of the respondents are U.S. citizens, 88% being White/Caucasian and almost 7% being American Indian. Seventy-two percent are female and twenty-eight percent are male. Fifty percent of those replying are between the ages of 22 and 27. The ages of another 29% are between 28 and 40. The GPA of 85% of the respondents is above a 3.0 and, generally, almost half of respondents' current salaries are above \$40,000 annually.

Next is a summary report of data. The number of responses for each item varies since not all graduates responded to each item, and some items allowed more than one response. Analyses use the number of response per item.

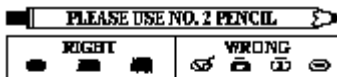
