The new award was created by the Pharmacy Alumni Association to recognize outstanding service to the College of Pharmacy and the Pharmacy Alumni Association.

It also recognizes the achievements of an individual working on behalf of the College of Pharmacy through service in alumni programs, on advisory committees or through efforts made to ensure the welfare of the College of Pharmacy.
