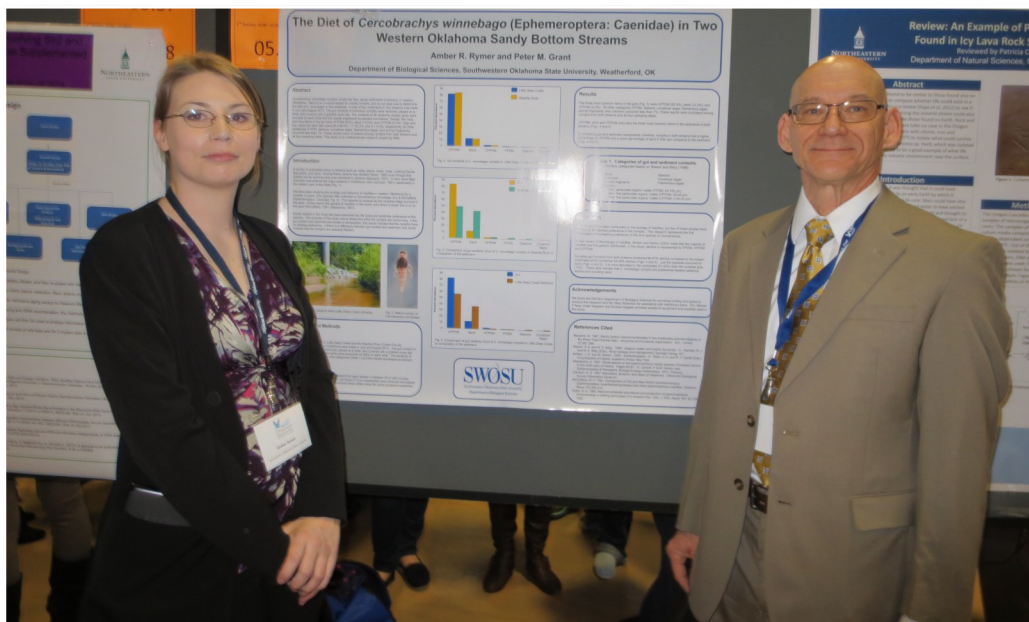

OKLAHOMA RESEARCH DAY

Sixty students and twenty faculty members from Southwestern Oklahoma State University participated in the 16th annual Oklahoma Research Day held at the University of Central Oklahoma (UCO) in Edmond, Oklahoma, on March 7, 2014.

Oklahoma Research Day provides an opportunity for all Oklahoma university students and faculty from all disciplines to showcase their research activities. SWOSU students and faculty presented more than 45 projects.

The event was sponsored by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education (OSRHE), the Oklahoma Experimental Program for Stimulating Competitive Research—National Science Foundation, the Oklahoma IDEa Network for Biomedical Re-

search Excellence—National Institutes of Health, and Oklahoma Regional Universities. It was organized by the Office of the Provost, Academic Affairs, of UCO in cooperation with the Council on Research for Regional Universities and the UCO Office of Research and Grants.

The 2014 Oklahoma Research Day also featured a number of prominent speakers including Dr. Glen D. Johnson, Chancellor for OSRHE; Dr. Don Betz, President of UCO; Dr. John Barthell, Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs for UCO; Dr. Gregory M. Wilson, Assistant Vice President, Office of Research and Grants at UCO; and keynote speaker Mr. James Milt Heflin, Jr., retired official from the National Aeronautics and Space Administration.
