# Friday's COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic Still Scheduled to Take Place

Tomorrow's (Friday, Feb. 19) COVID-19 vaccination clinic at Southwestern Oklahoma State University's Pioneer Cellular Event Center (700 N. Seventh Street) will take place.

SWOSU is working to clear parking lots, and the City of Weatherford is clearing main roads to the center.

All appointments are set up through the online portal of the Oklahoma State Department of Health (OSDH): <https://vaccinate.oklahoma.gov/>. The clinics should continue Fridays for several months at SWOSU.

SWOSU College of Pharmacy Rural Health Center Coordinator Randy Curry encourages everyone to sign up on the OSDH scheduler, and it will place everyone in the appropriate category for vaccines.

Residents coming to the Pioneer Cellular Event Center should enter through the west doors. Appointments are required. Masks and distancing are required.
