
Dear Tom:

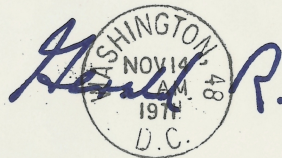
