
Dear Mrs. Stafford:

It was a pleasure to meet you on what I know must have been one of the proudest, happiest days of your life.

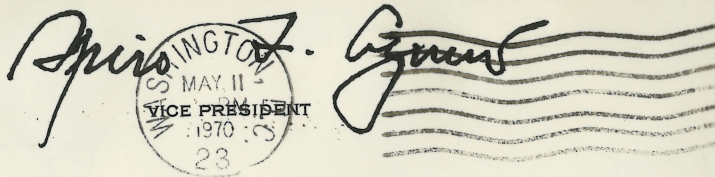
Over the months I have come to know Tom well, and he is a fine man. I am very happy to have had the opportunity to take part in the dedication of the airfield named in honor of your son.
