## Neff Hall

Named for Prof. Audubon Henry Neff, head of Southwestern's Biology department since 1915, Neff Hall is the residence of 126 of our men students. The Hall abounds in recreational facilities. Built in 1937 at the time Stewart Hall was constructed; this building is one of the most modern dormitories in the Southwest.

## Stewart Hall

Stewart Hall, Southwestern's new, modern dormitory for women, was built in 1937 and dedicated to Dr. Dora Ann Stewart, beloved professor of History and Government at the college since 1909. Stewart Hall, housing 144 students, also contains the large dining room used jointly by both the dormitories, and is the scene of many of the all-school functions which highlight the year.
