SWOSU-Sayre Financial Aid Director Ron Kistler and assistant Nancy Sanders will help parents and students complete their application and answer any questions about financial aid for college.

"We will actually help them complete the on-line FAFSA application in our computer lab on campus," Kistler said. "Anyone who needs assistance completing the FAFSA is welcome to attend."

Kistler said that parents and students need to bring their completed 2011 income tax information or their W-2's as well as their driver's licenses.
