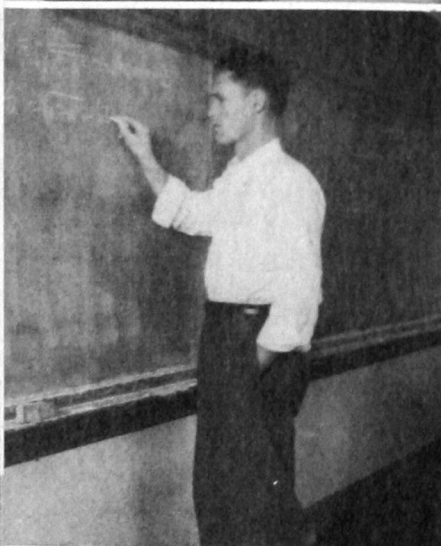

Our president is one of the very few college presidents who have learned to fly. Below is a picture of him and his plane.



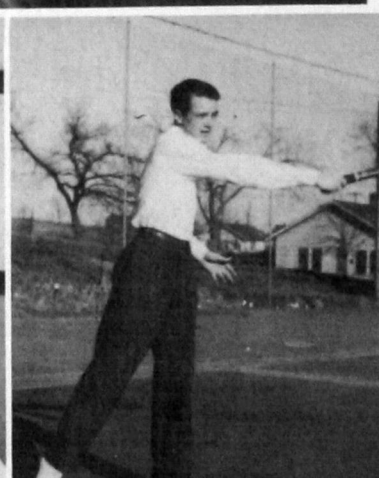

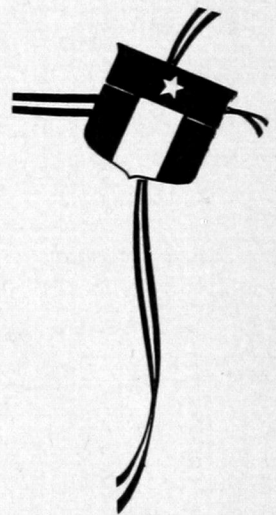

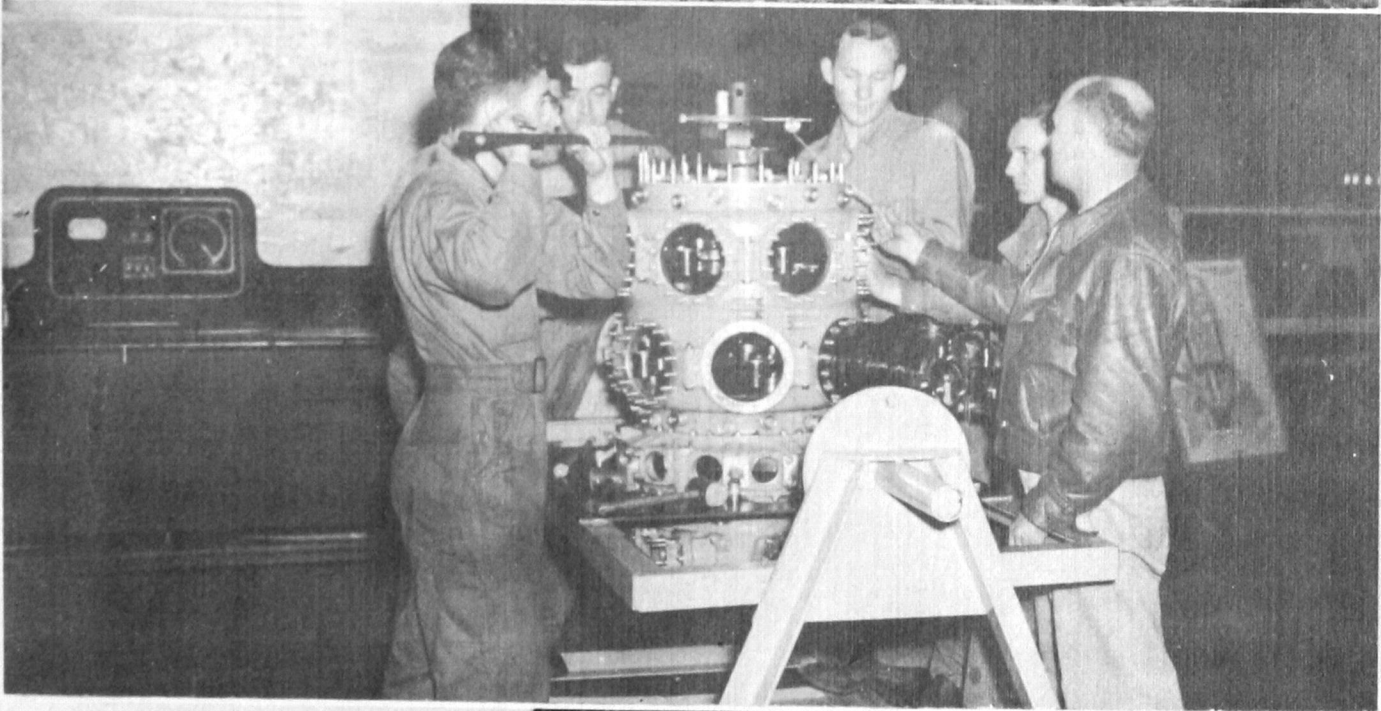

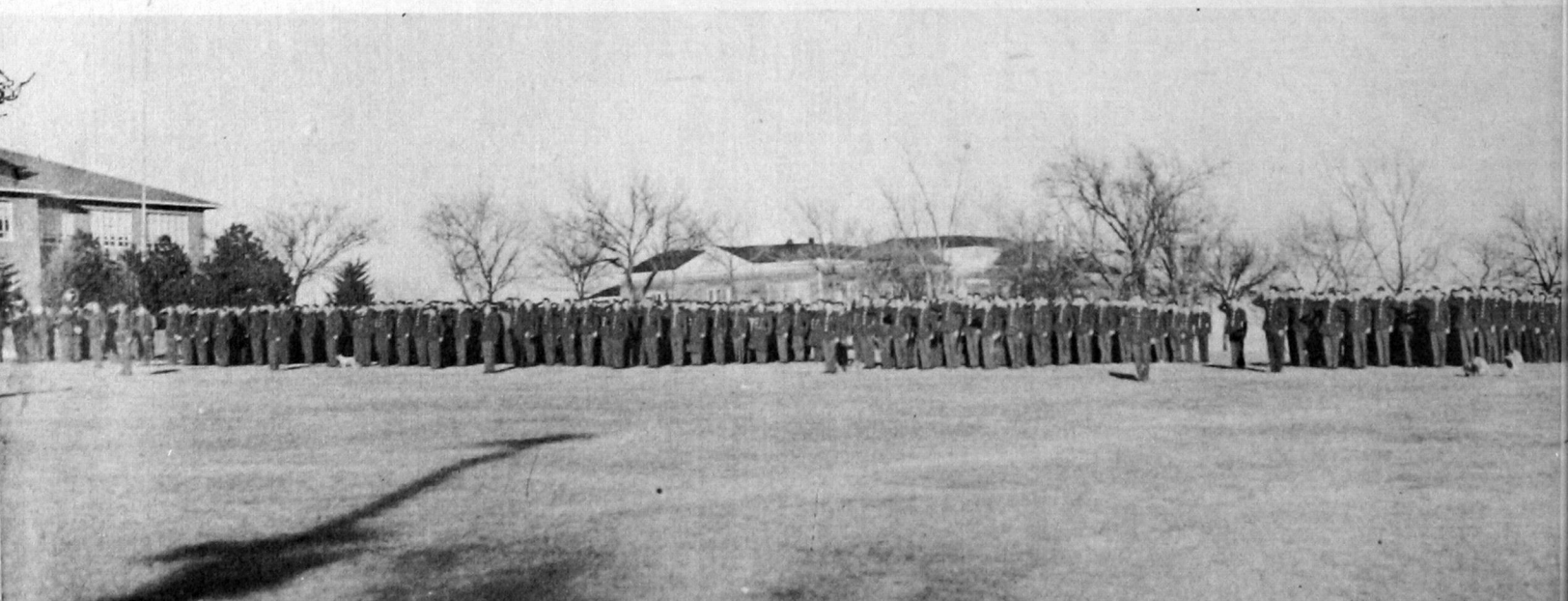

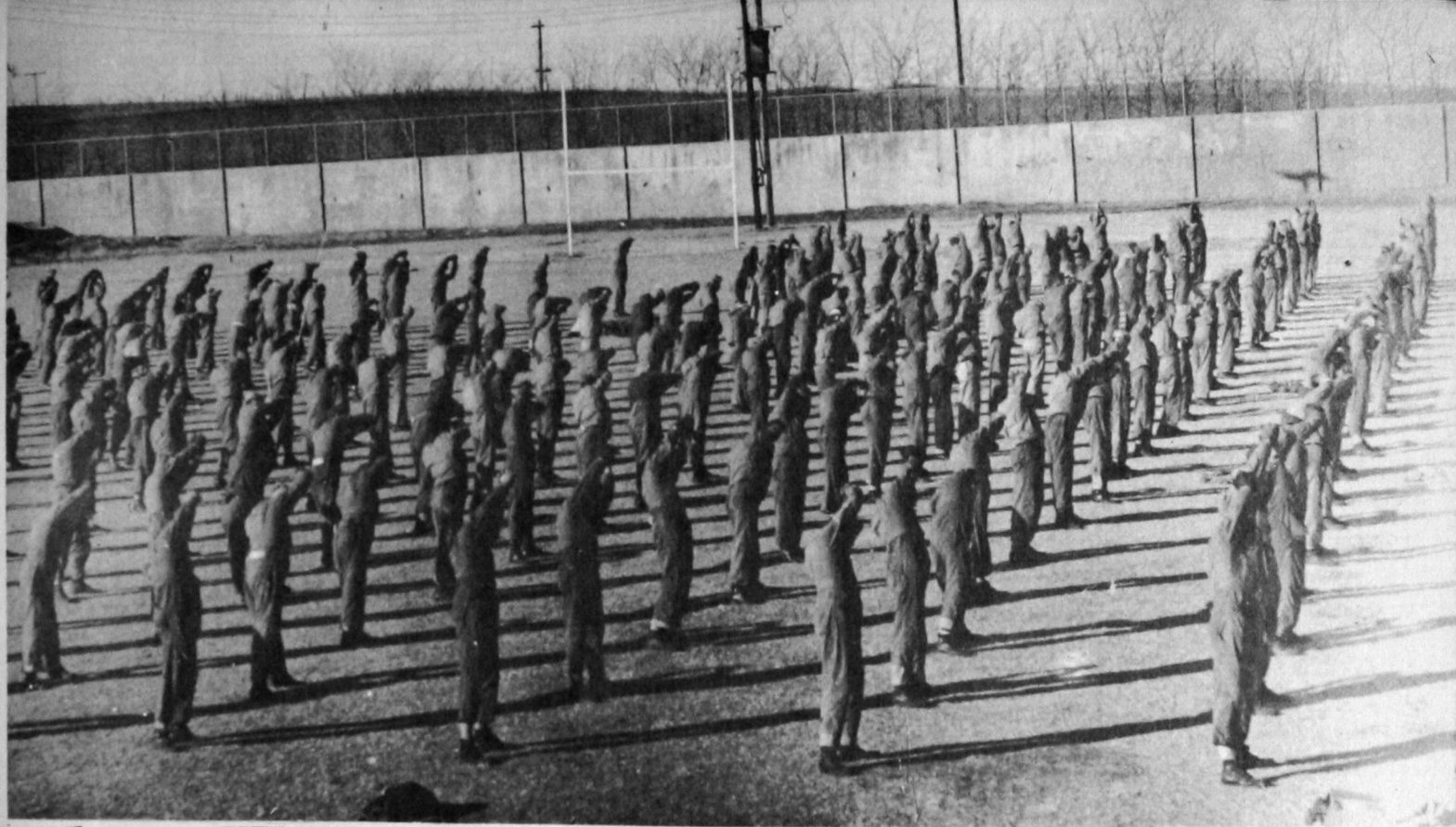
