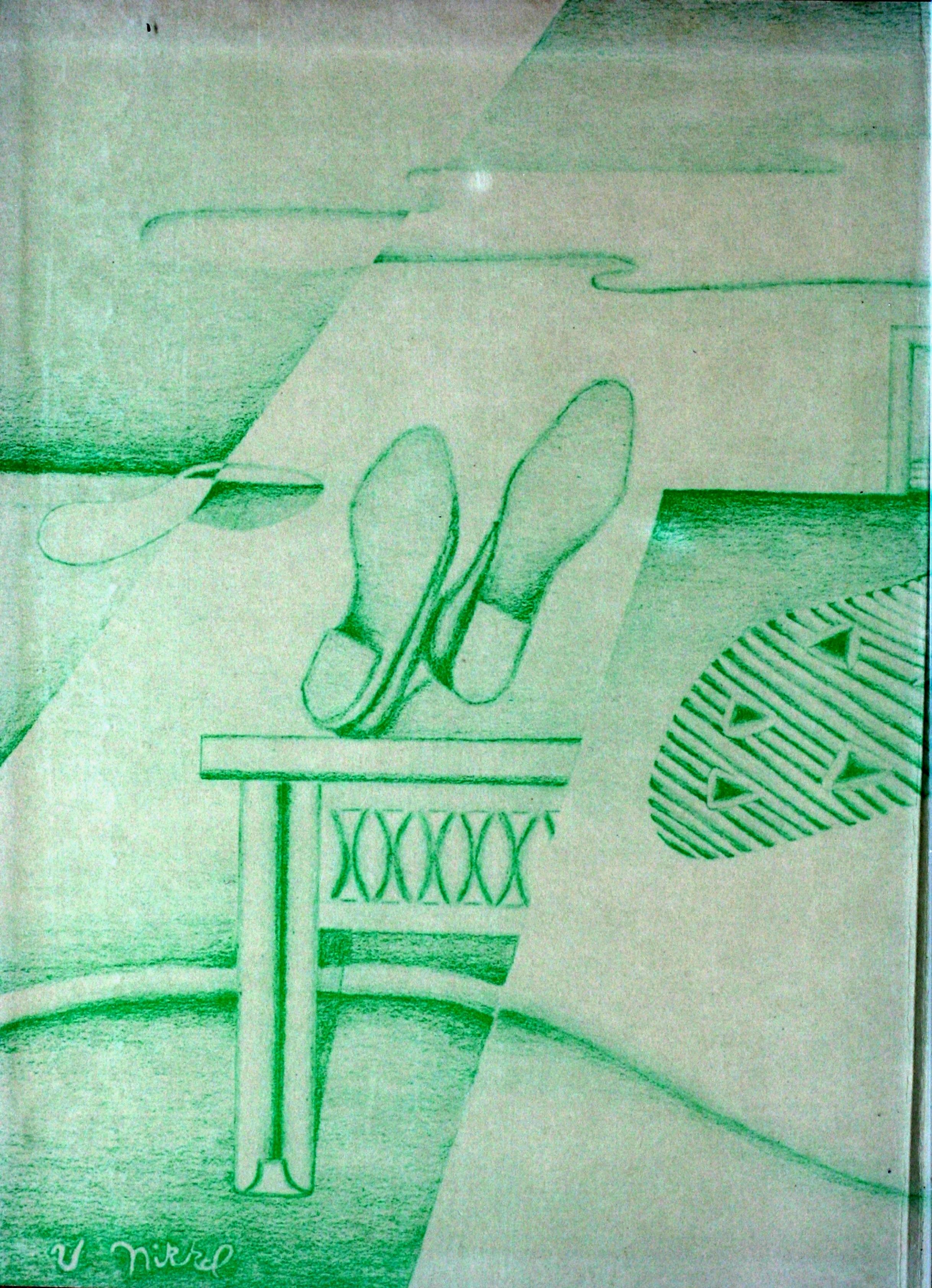

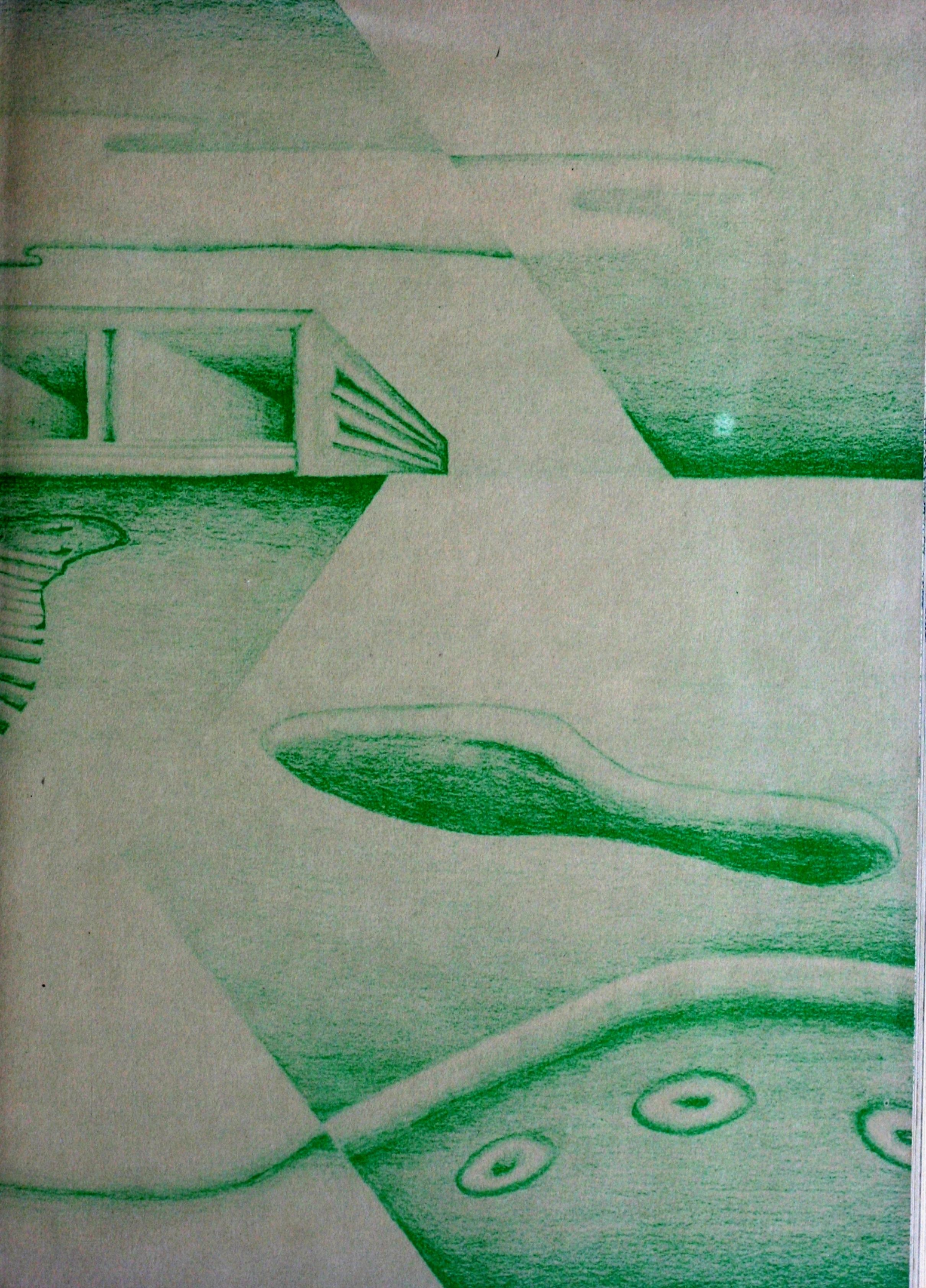

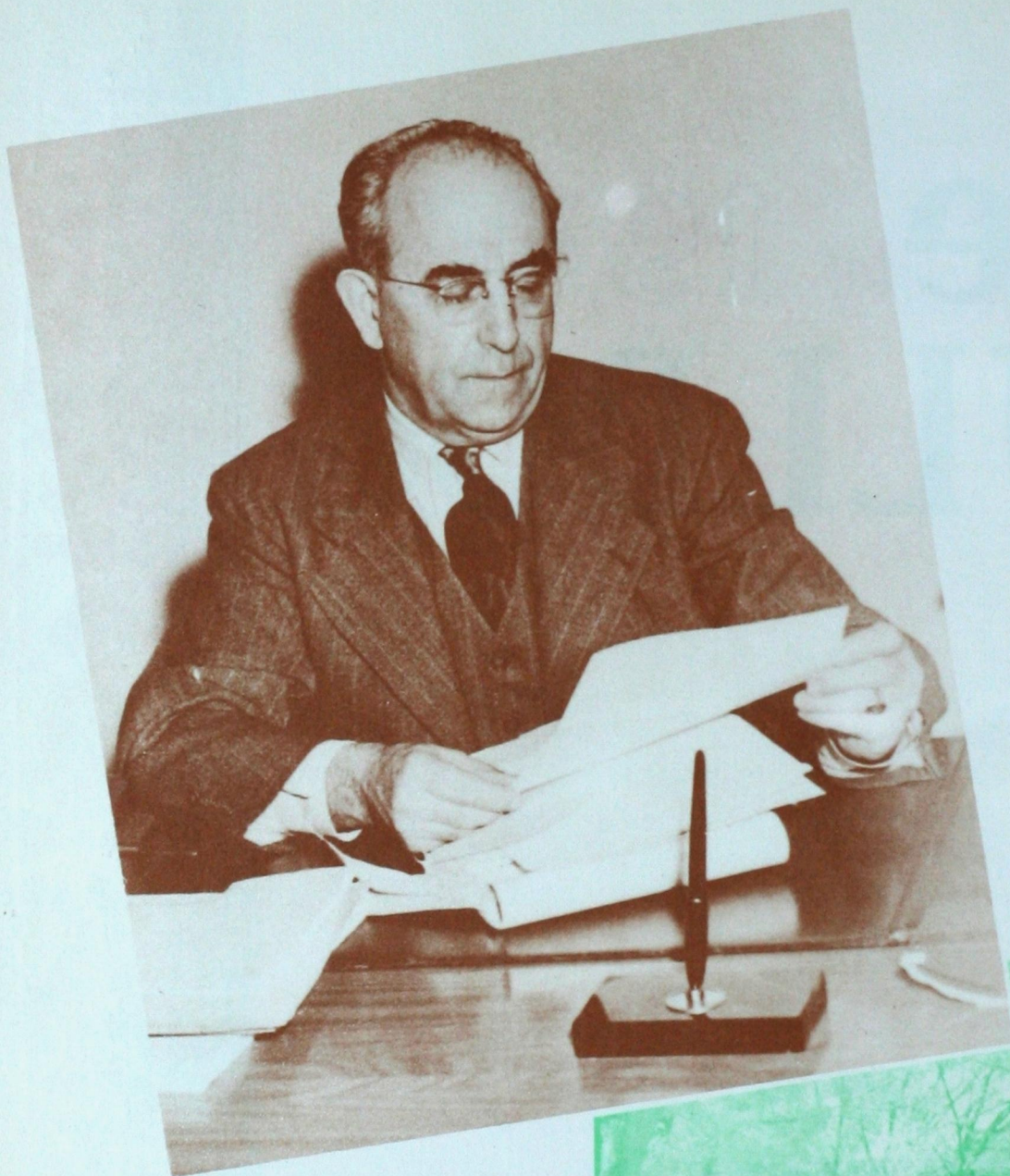

## President's Message

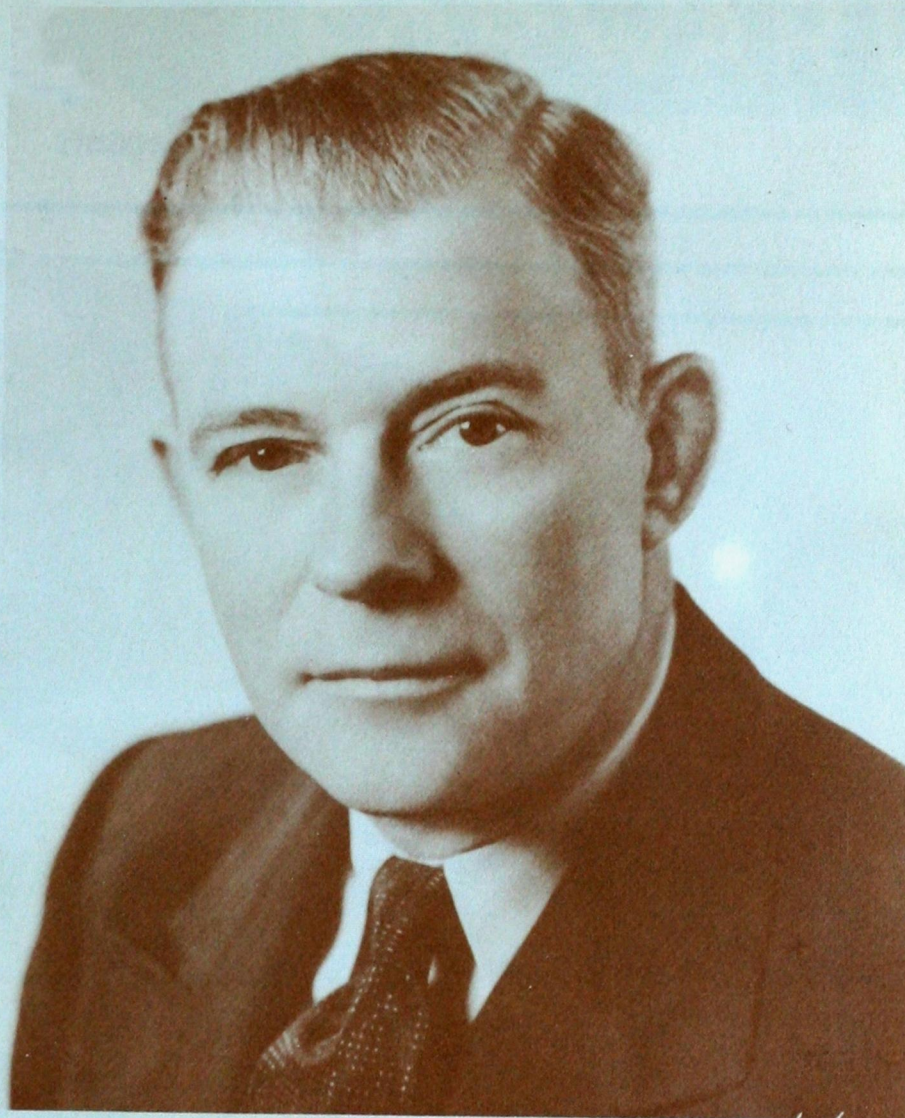
Let me take this opportunity to congratulate the editorial staff and its sponsor on this splendid issue of the Bulldog.

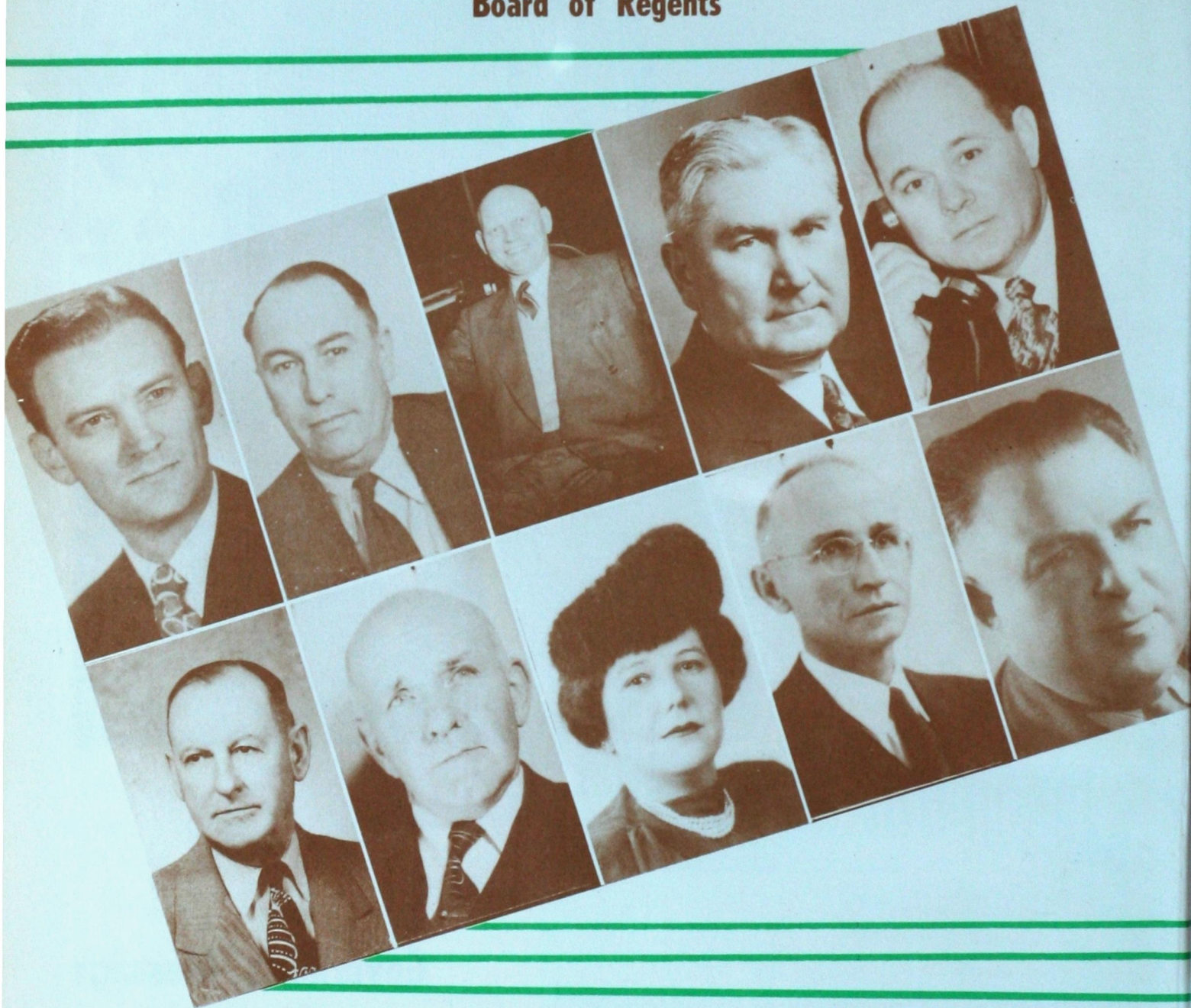
## Governor's Message
