Finally we would like to thank the APOTHECARY staff for their hard work, time, efforts, and talents in providing a most successful year.

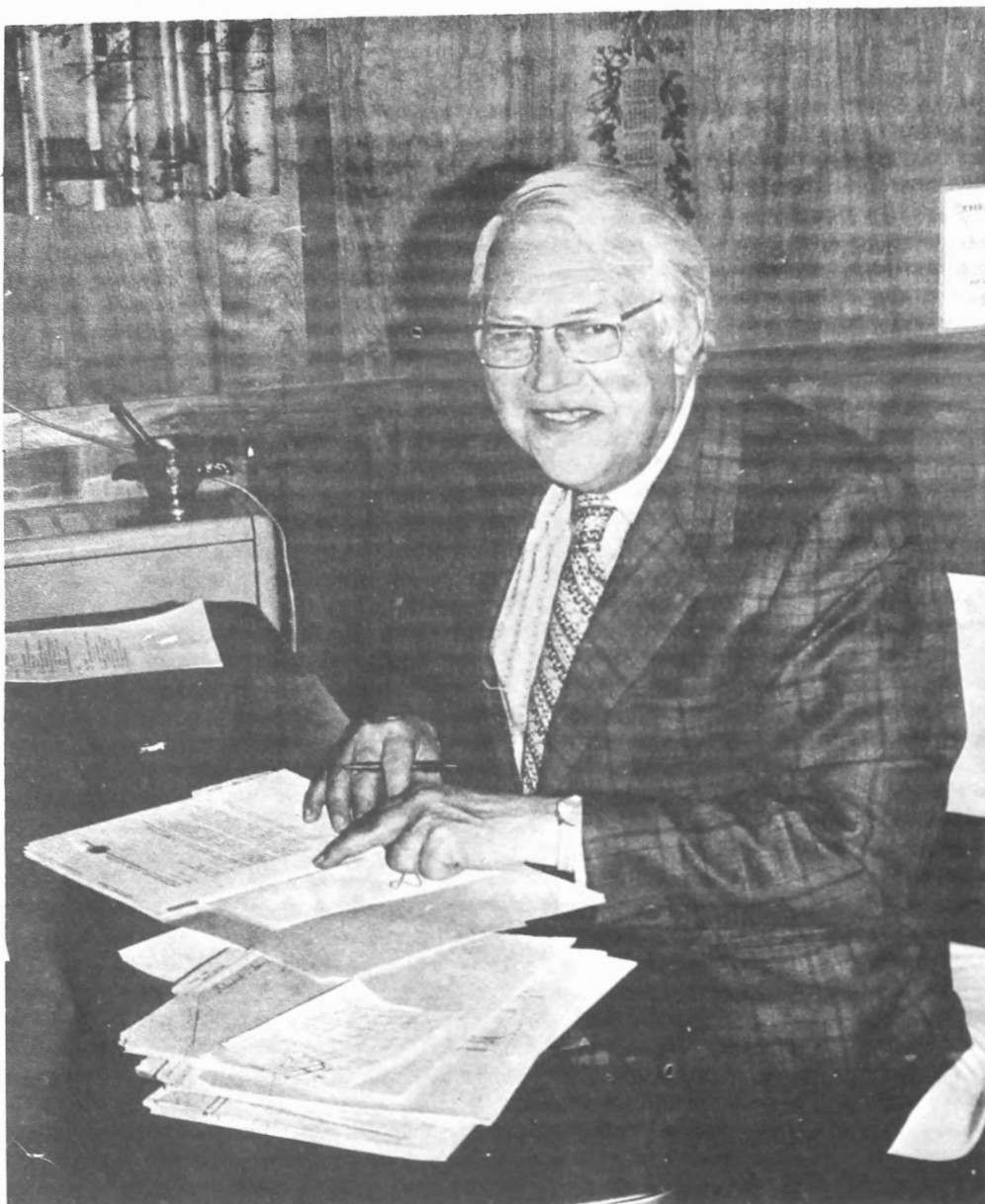

WALTER L. DICKISON, PH.D.  
DEAN, SCHOOL OF PHARMACY

It was sixteen years ago when Dr. Walter L. Dickison joined the faculty at Southwestern State College. On June 1, 1965, Dr. Dickison became Dean of the School of Pharmacy, the position which he presently holds.

Dean Dickison received a B.S. in Chemistry from Central Missouri State in 1939 and went on to teach chemistry in the Missouri Public Schools. Dr. Dickison received his B.S. in Pharmacy from the University of Colorado. In 1951, he entered partnership in a drug business in Texas. Dr. Dickison pursued this career for four years before returning to the University of Colorado in 1955 to continue his graduate studies. Dean Dickison completed his Ph.D. work in 1957 and then joined the faculty here at Southwestern.

In spite of his busy schedule, Dr. Dickison finds time to

participate in such organizations as APhA, OPhA, Phi Delta Chi, Rho Chi, Sigma Xi, Phi Lambda Upsilon, OEA, AACP, AAAS, and the American Board of Diplomats in Pharmacy. Dr. Dickison was appointed in March to the FDA's Non-Prescription Drug Review Panel. Dr. Dickison is the only pharmacist on the seven-member panel, the other six members being doctors of medicine. He is also an active member of the Baptist Church, Chamber of Commerce, and Rotary.

Probably the highlight of this year for Dean Dickison was his tour of England and France where he visited pharmacy education facilities in both countries.

Dr. Dickison's family consists of his lovely wife, Virginia, his son Jim of Denver, Colo., and daughter Jane of Oklahoma City.



## *Dean's Advisory Council*



Among the many organizations sanctioned by the School of Pharmacy is the Dean's Advisory Council. One of its many purposes is to bridge the gap between faculty and students by allowing the students to voice their opinions and recommendations. Once a month a representative from each of the professional organizations and each of the five classes meet together with the Dean.

MRS. IMO JEAN CLARK

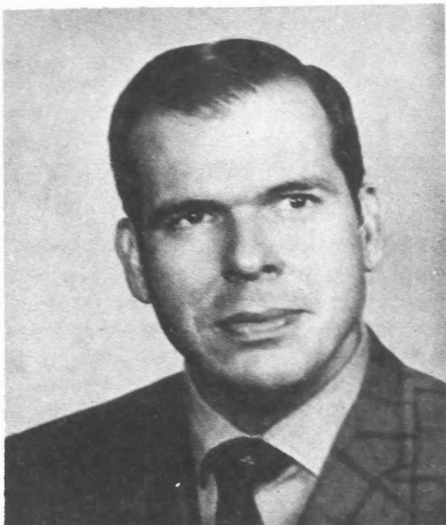

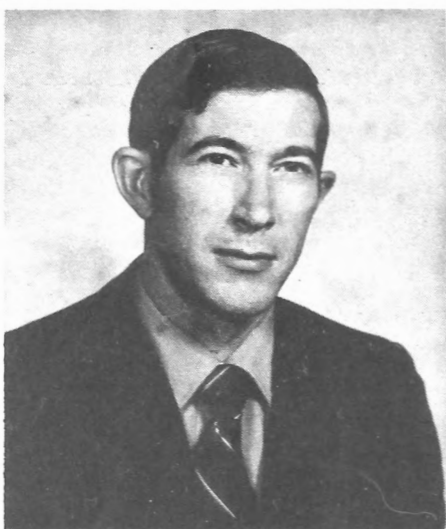
DR. BERNARD G. KELLER, JR.

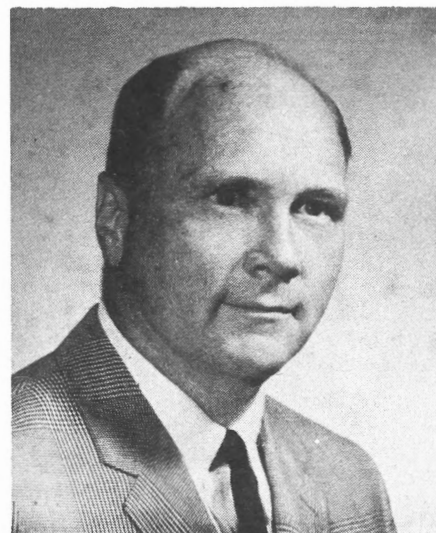
DR. CHARLES SCHWARTZ

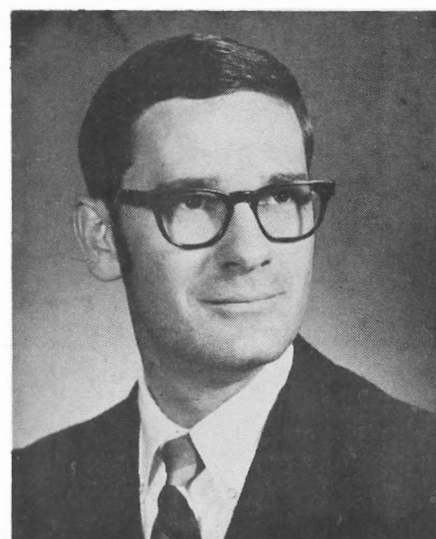
MR. EDWARD C. CHRISTENSEN

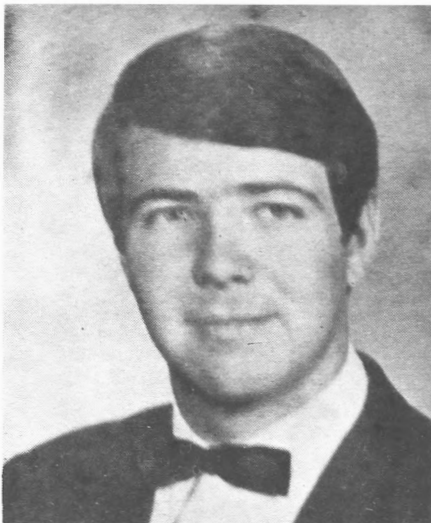
MR. GARY PORTER

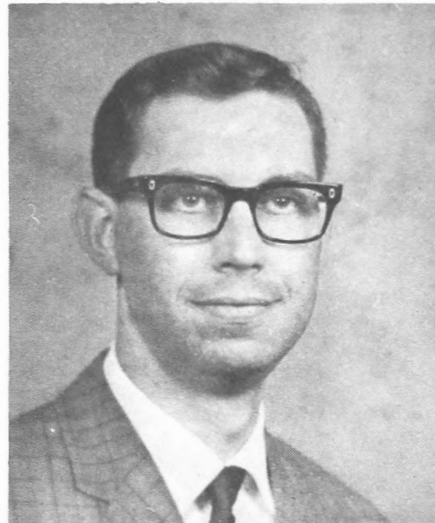
MR. ROBERT MAYNARD

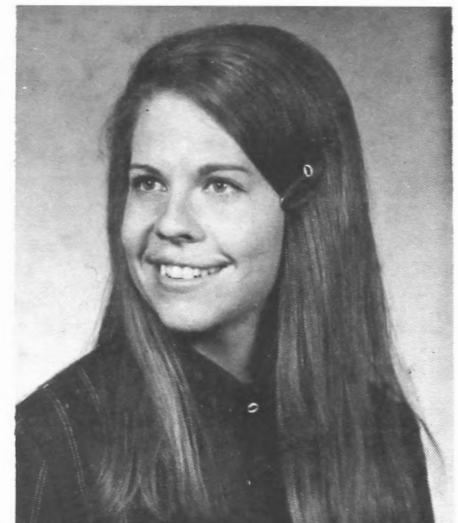
MR. TERRY L. DAVIDSON

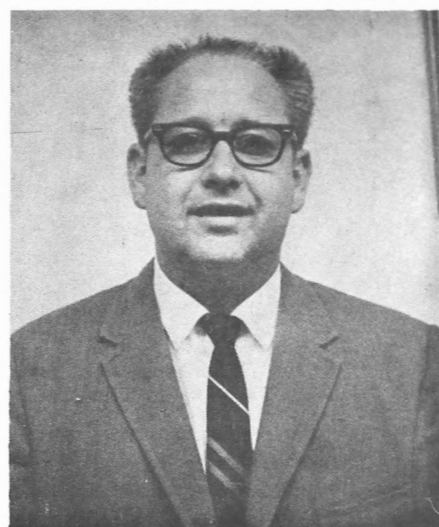
MRS. GEANENE SCHAFER

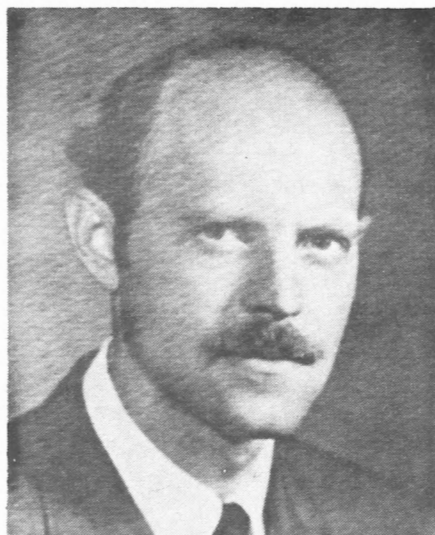
MR. MERLE BONNER

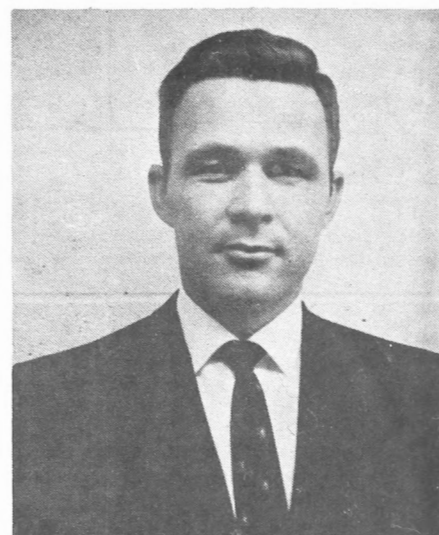
DR. BUFF B. BURTIS, JR.

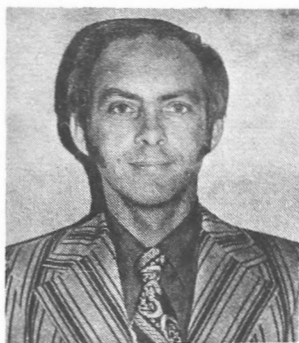

Dreams do oft times become a reality. Such is evidenced by the 5057 Professional Practice Program, without a doubt a well-established, well-organized clinical concept.

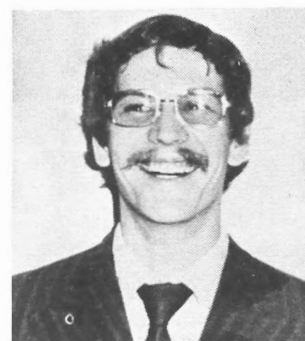

With the appointment of Dr. Keller as Assistant Dean, the program was expanded with the addition of four Public Health Service Hospitals and one community hospital. The capacity at St. Anthony Hospital was also increased and now the program is capable of handling 120 students per calendar year. The program is now a required course and will be further expanded in the near future to accommodate all the students who enter their senior year.

For nine weeks a student is placed in a professional environment under the direction of a registered practicing pharmacist. While working in the pharmacy the student is given instruction in all aspects of operation and management. He also works hand-in-hand with the instructor-pharmacist in dealing with physicians, nurses, dentists, and patients.

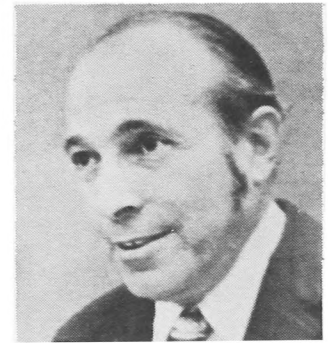

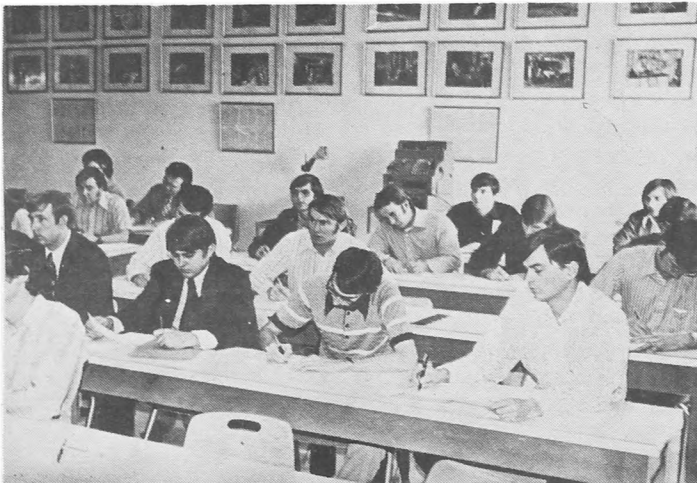

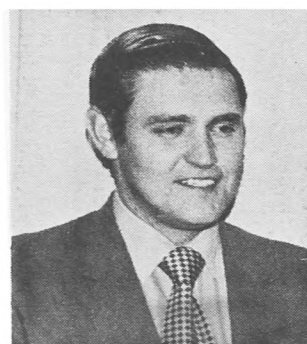


This on-the-job training helps ease the transition from an academic setting to practice in much the same way that clinical practice eases the transition in other health professions.

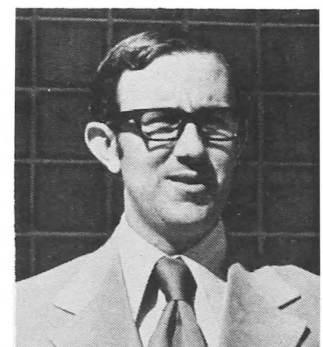

We would like to thank Dean Dickison for all of his efforts and time and also Eli Lilly and Company for a wonderful and informative trip.

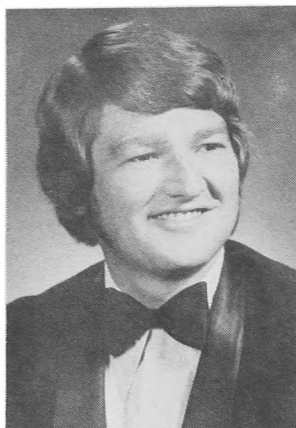




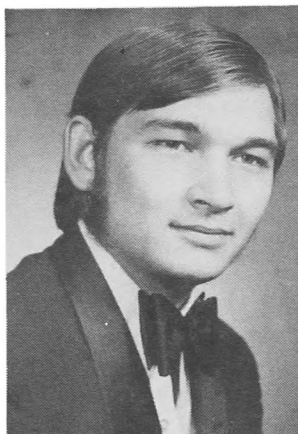

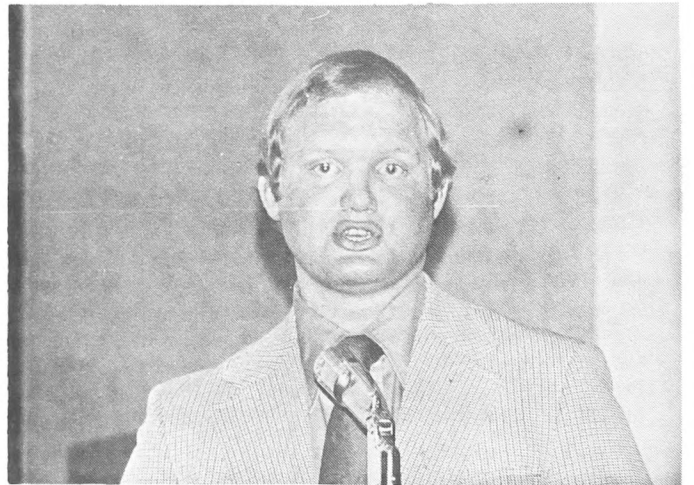
This year's activities, as with years past, began with the SWPhA picnic held at Mean's Park in September. The faculty grilled the hamburgers, while the students, under the direction

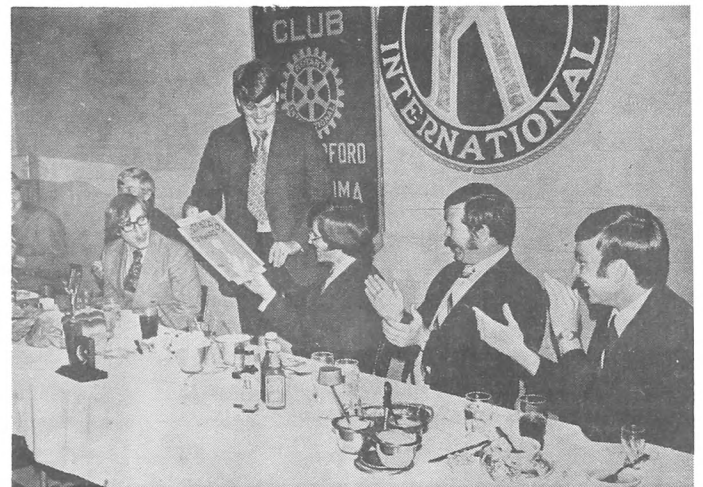

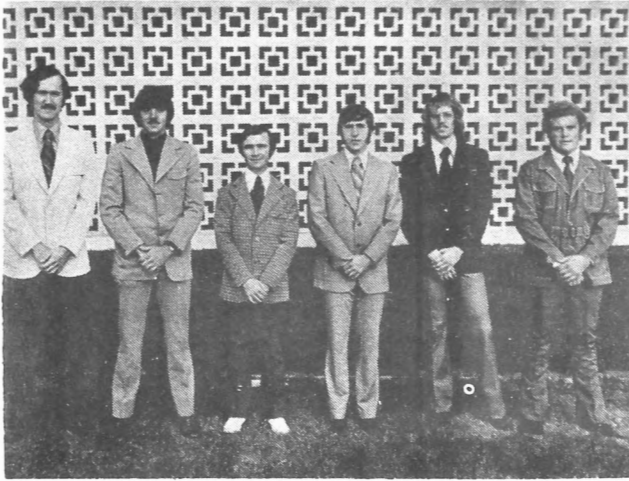

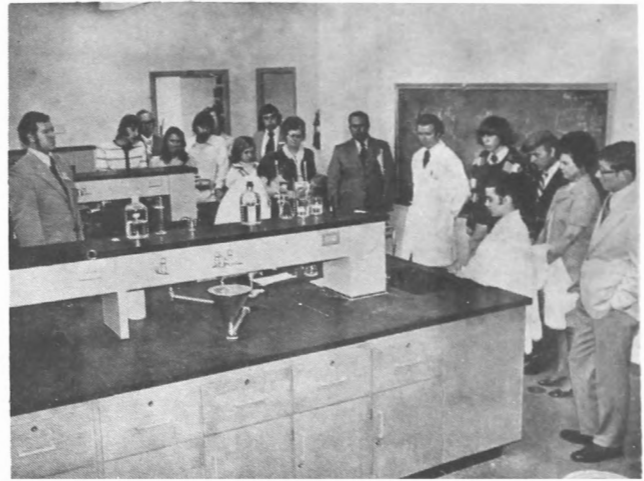

All in all, it was a most interesting and exciting and event-filled year for the Phi Delta Chi Brothers.

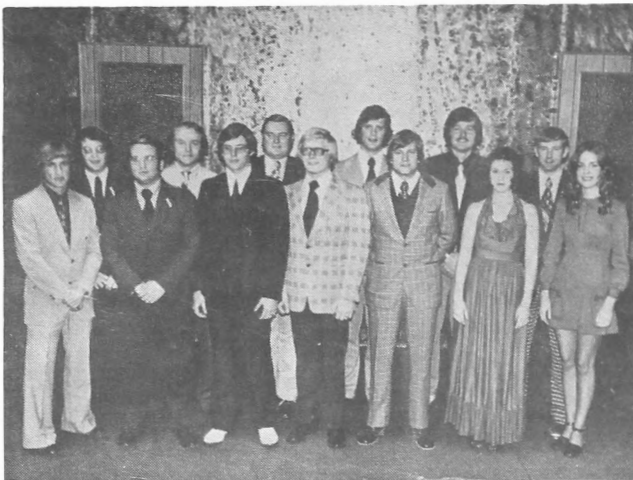

We departed Alcon Labs and checked in the Rodeway Inn. Thursday evening's entertainment consisted of dinner and the

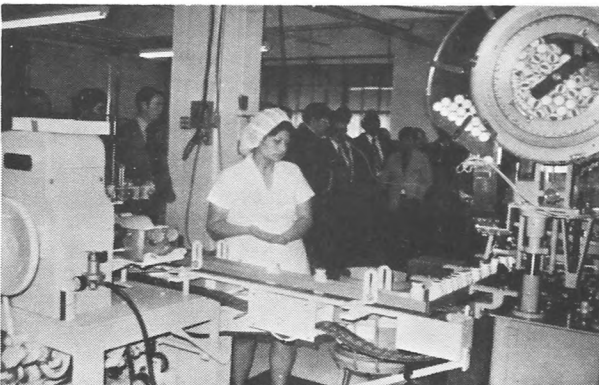
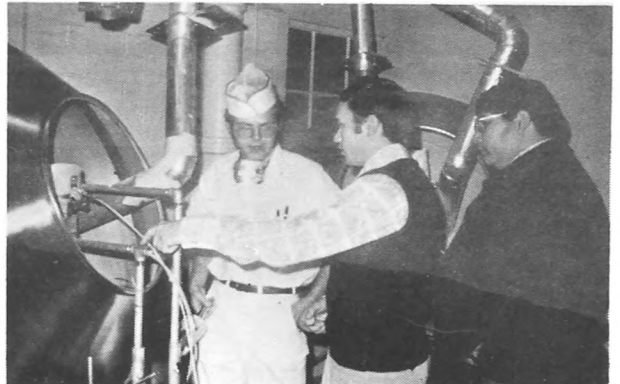
play "Mary, Mary" at the Windmill Dinner Theater. The play starred Marjorie Lord and A. Paul Smith and was enjoyed by all.

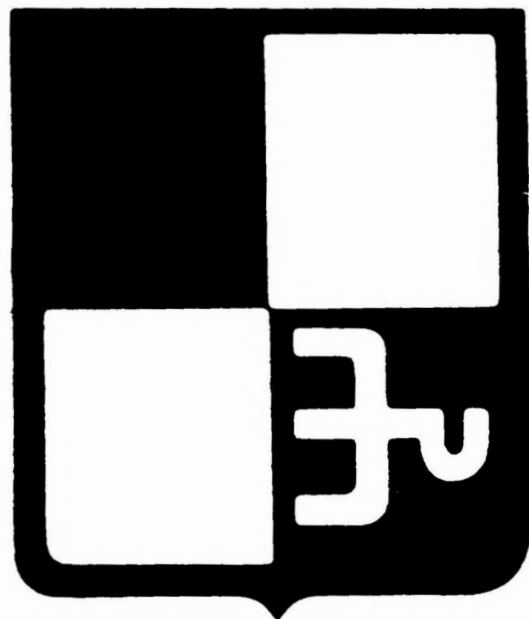
The FDA Labs were our last stop. Then we departed a bit ahead of schedule for Weatherford.

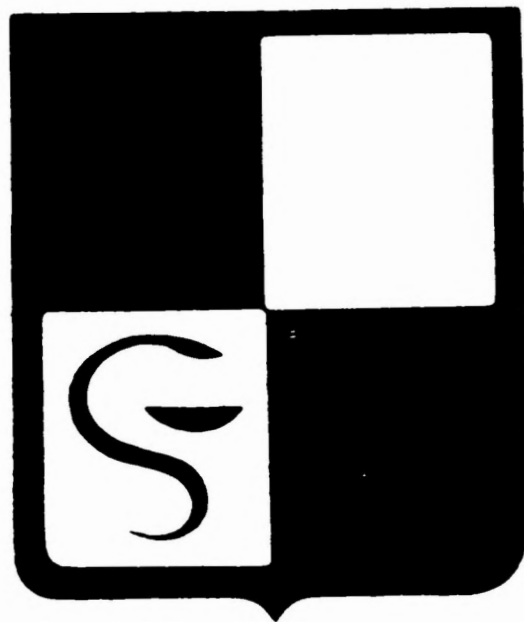

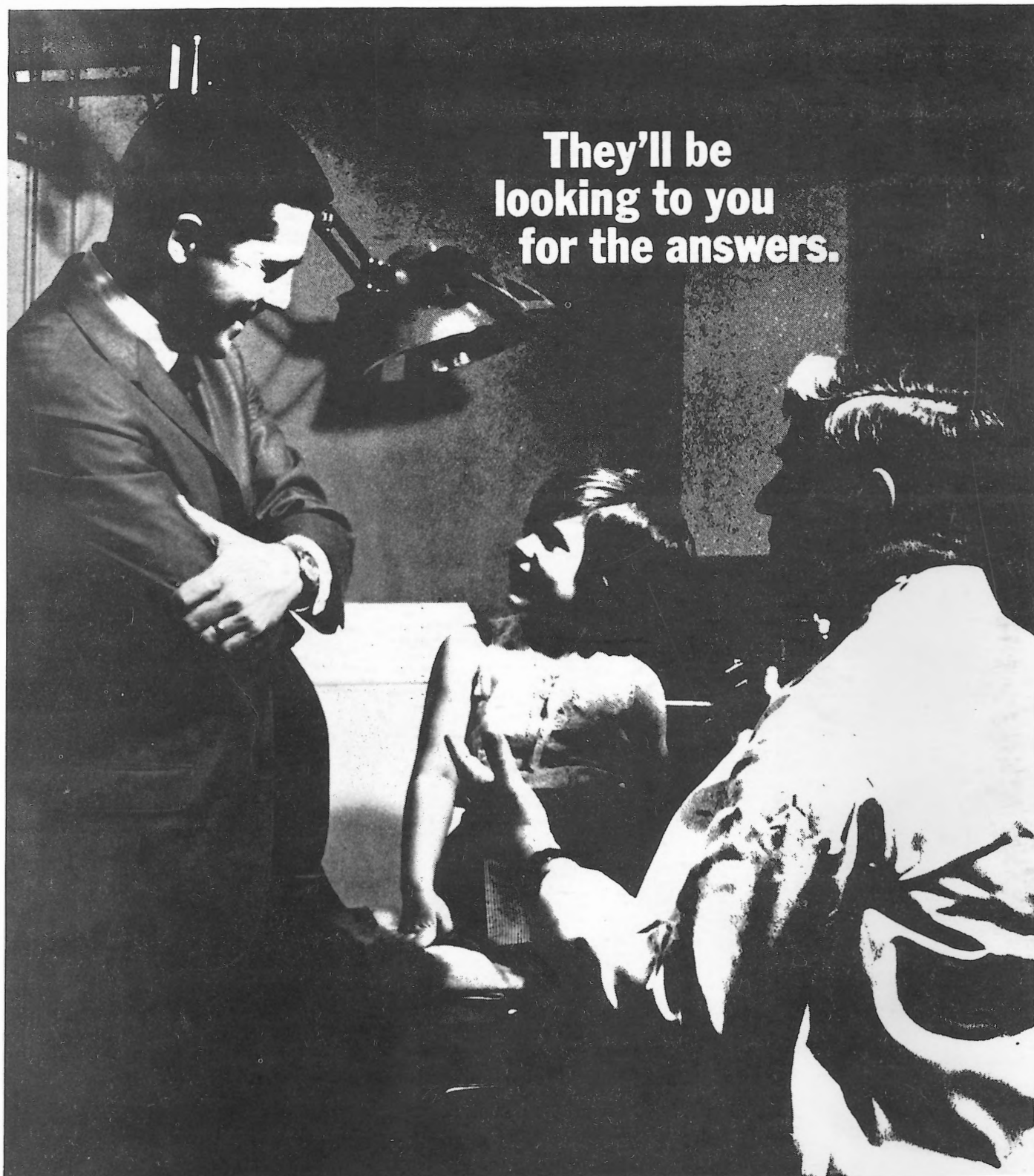
