Two More COVID-19 Vaccine Opportunities Coming Up at SWOSU

COVID-19 vaccination clinics are set for this Friday, March 26, and Tuesday, March 30, at the Pioneer Cellular Event Center on the Southwestern Oklahoma State University campus in Weatherford.

Dr. Randy Curry, director of the SWOSU College of Pharmacy Rural Health Center, said Friday's clinic will be from 9 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. with 1,300 appointments (1st and 2nd Pfizer doses) available through the Oklahoma State Department of Health portal—<https://vaccinate.oklahoma.gov/en-US/>. This clinic is for all people in phases 1 through 3 of the Oklahoma state vaccination plan.

Curry said it is important to make appointments through the portal to help manage the vaccine doses. For people having problems signing up, call 580.774.3025.

Tuesday's clinic will be from 9 a.m. until 12 noon and is available for all phases from 1-4. This will be the first opportunity for people in phase 4 to get the vaccine. For this clinic, make appointments by calling 580.774.3025.
