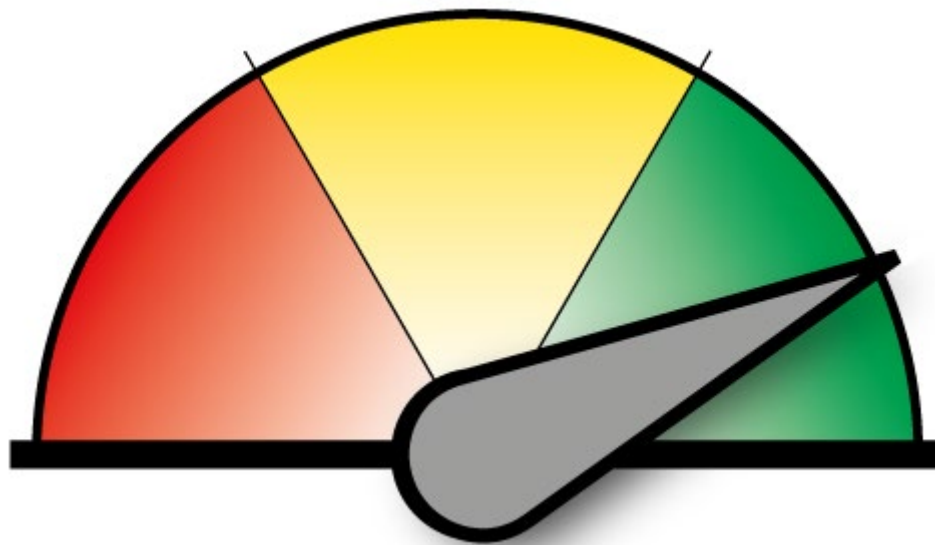

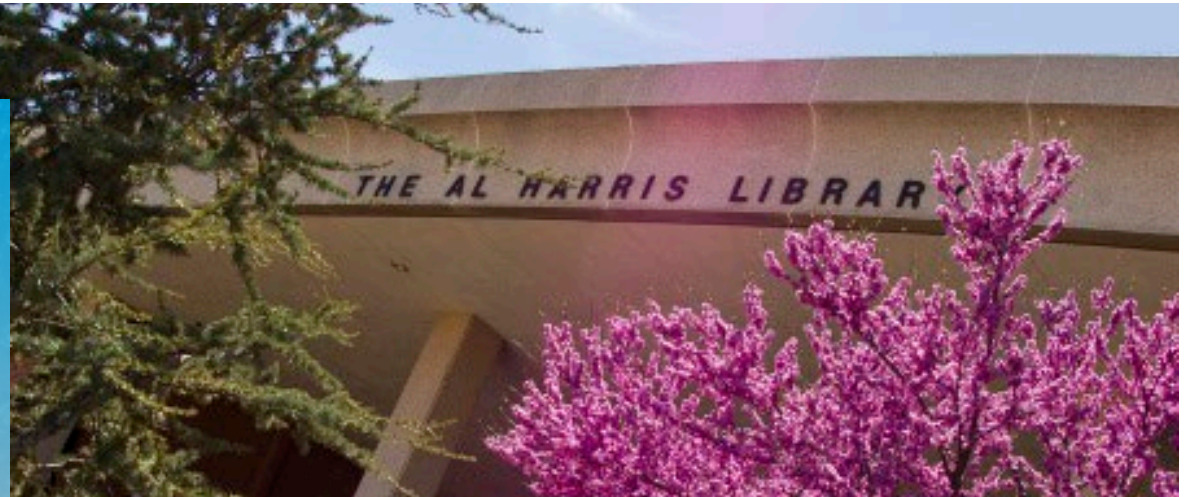

# Comparison statistics from other platforms

- *Mythlore* is included in full-text or indexed on most of the major library database platforms:
  - Cengage/Gale
  - Ebsco
  - ProQuest
  - JSTOR
  - SCOPUS
- On these platforms, you will find *Mythlore* in individual indexes like the *MLA Bibliography*, *Literature Online*, *American Theological Library Association* database, and more
- And yes, the Society gets a bit of money out of all these arrangements whenever someone downloads an article
- But otherwise, why do we need these IN ADDITION TO the SWOSU archive?

# ATLA (American Theological Library Association) database

- *Mythlore* has been indexed off-and-on in ATLA since its beginning. Last year we reached an agreement to provide ALL of our content to ATLA, back to the beginning.
- ATLA increases the exposure of our content to users interested in religion, philosophy, comparative mythology, and related topics.
- As of the end of May 2024, they had 2215 entries for *Mythlore* content.
- From September 2023 through May 2024, there were 1741 downloads of our articles and 2083 hits on the bibliographic records for articles (that is, the user opened the record but did not download the item).



- *Mythlore/Tolkien Journal* is included in the *Lives of Literature* collection
- From July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024, users downloaded 1818 of our articles.
- There were 91,229 total downloads in this period!
- Top five articles requested:
  - “Mythology in Children’s Animation” by David Emerson, 2019, #38.1
  - “Archetypes, Stereotypes, and the Female Hero” by Terri Frontgia, 1991, #18.1
  - “Types of Heroism in The Lord of the Rings” by Romuald Lakowski, 2002, #23.4
  - “Innocence as a Super-power: Little Girls on the Hero’s Journey” by David Emerson, 2009, #28.1/2
  - “Into the Wild Woods” by Weronika Łaszkiewicz, 2017, #36.1

# Accessible from anywhere

- Since 2016, almost 2,000 *Mythlore* works have been downloaded 794,356 times from 15,825 institutions in every country on the planet.
- Since 2019, more than 900 works in *The Mythic Circle* have been downloaded 19,140 times from 767 institutions in 128 countries.
- Since 2022, 184 works from *Mythprint* have been downloaded almost 4,000 times from 82 institutions in 87 countries.

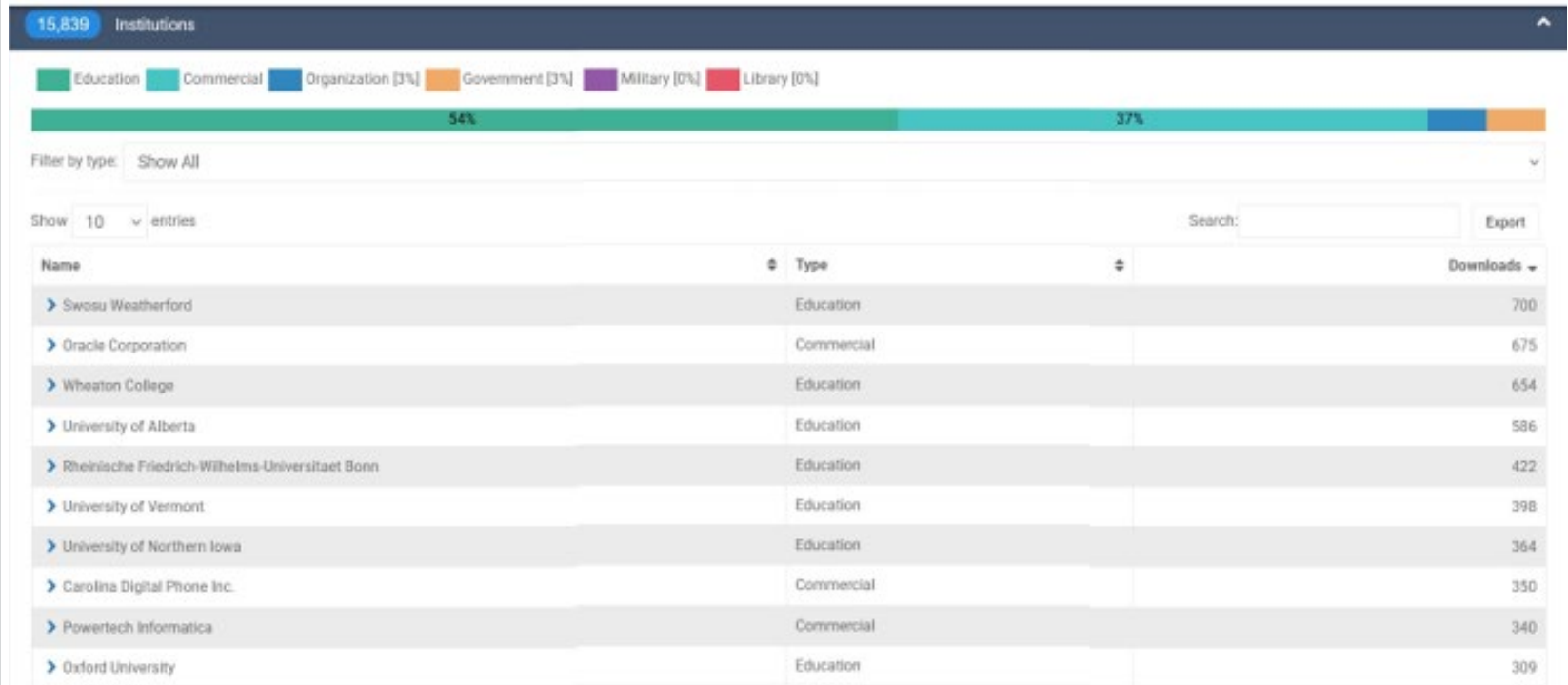
