BALLOT

Because of the as yet light vote on the Bylaw amendment given in the January 1977 *Mythprint*, the Council of Stewards has voted to extend the deadline from January 31 to April 30, 1977 for post-marked ballots to be accepted.

CONSIDER THE ISSUE, AND THEN MAIL YOUR VOTE. See the January 1977 issue of *Mythprint* for statement of possible compromise. In summary, those in favor of amendment would like to see *Mythlore* enlarged from 40 to 48 pages an issue, and see *Mythprint* published 8 instead of 12 times a year — with 4 of the 8 issues included in *Mythlore* — and the other four issues published between issues of *Mythlore*, but enlarged from 4 to 6 or 8 pages. Those not in favor of the compromise amendment basically do not wish to see Activity Calendar information published less frequently than 12 times a year. DECIDE AND VOTE.
