



Tuesday Evening Jazz Concert Planned at SWOSU

An evening of jazz is planned Tuesday, March 13, at Southwestern Oklahoma State University in Weatherford.

The 8 p.m. concert in the Fine Arts Center will have a theme of jazz standards and feature some of the best-loved jazz pieces of all time. The free concert is sponsored by the SWOSU Music Department, and the public is invited to attend.

Jazz Ensemble B will start the evening with the classic Duke Ellington tune, *Caravan*, however, the arrangement performed will be the one made popular by the band Chicago. Joining Jazz Ensemble B later in the evening will be none other than SWOSU provost and outstanding trumpeter, Dr. James South. He will lend his sultry sound to a samba arrangement of the song, *Smoke Gets in Your Eyes*.

Student conductor Breydon Renard (junior music education major from Enid) will lead the band in a rendition of *How High the Moon* and Jazz Ensemble B's portion of the concert will conclude with Jimmy Smith's *Back at the Chicken Shack*.
