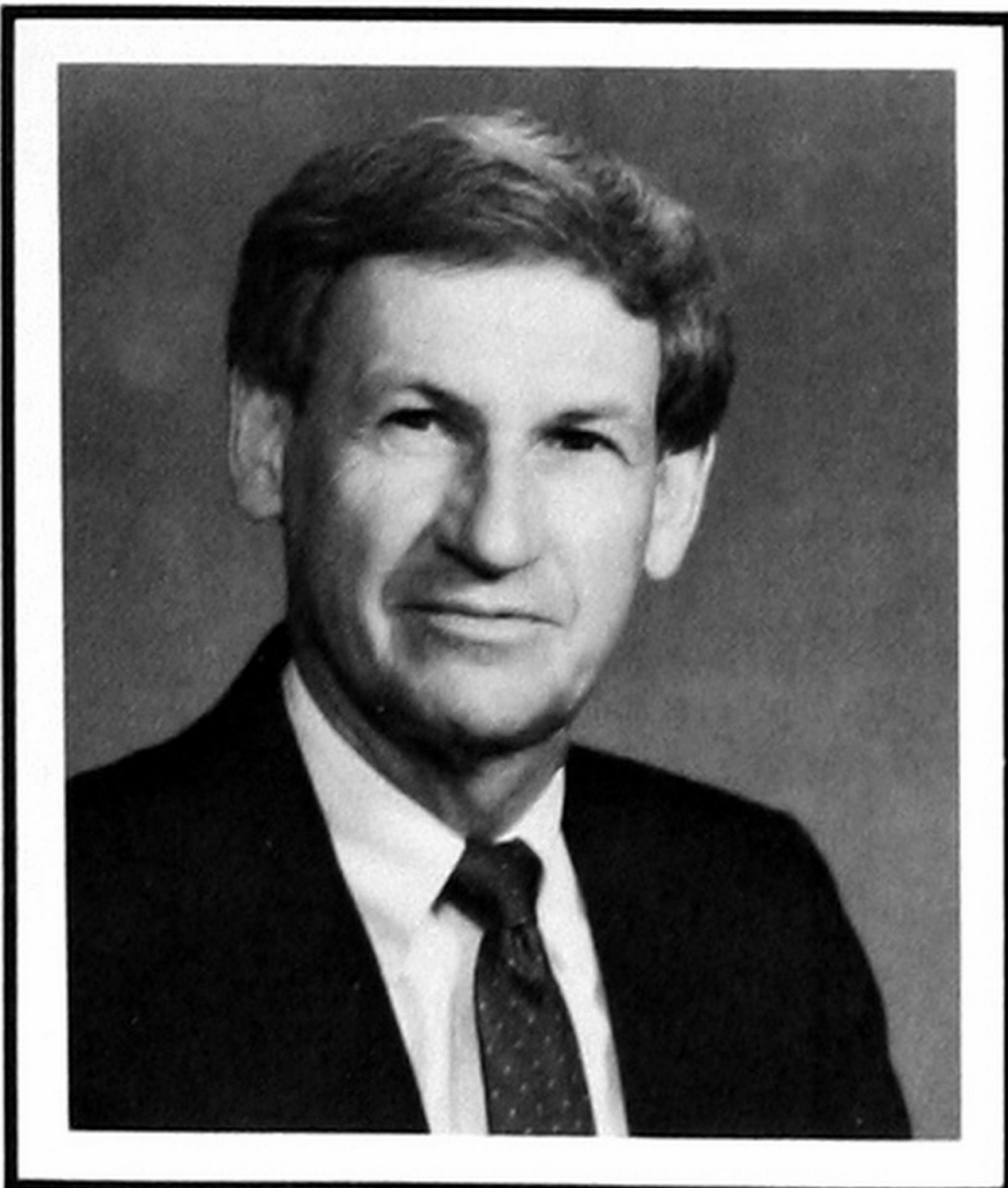
On the evening of Thursday, January 14, the citizens of western Oklahoma stepped forward and testified at a public hearing before the Oklahoma State Regents that Southwestern at Sayre meets a vital need in our part of the State. More importantly, the State Regents listened and revised their governance report to praise the 1987 merger of Sayre Junior College and Southwestern Oklahoma State University. The State Regents were impressed with the genuine support expressed by the citizens and by the positive progress that is evident in our academic programs and our facilities.

As a result of the passage of State Questions 649 and 650, the purchase of the Sayre campus will be completed this spring, and the construction of the Student Center will start this summer. Both projects are indicative of the strength of the people of western Oklahoma.

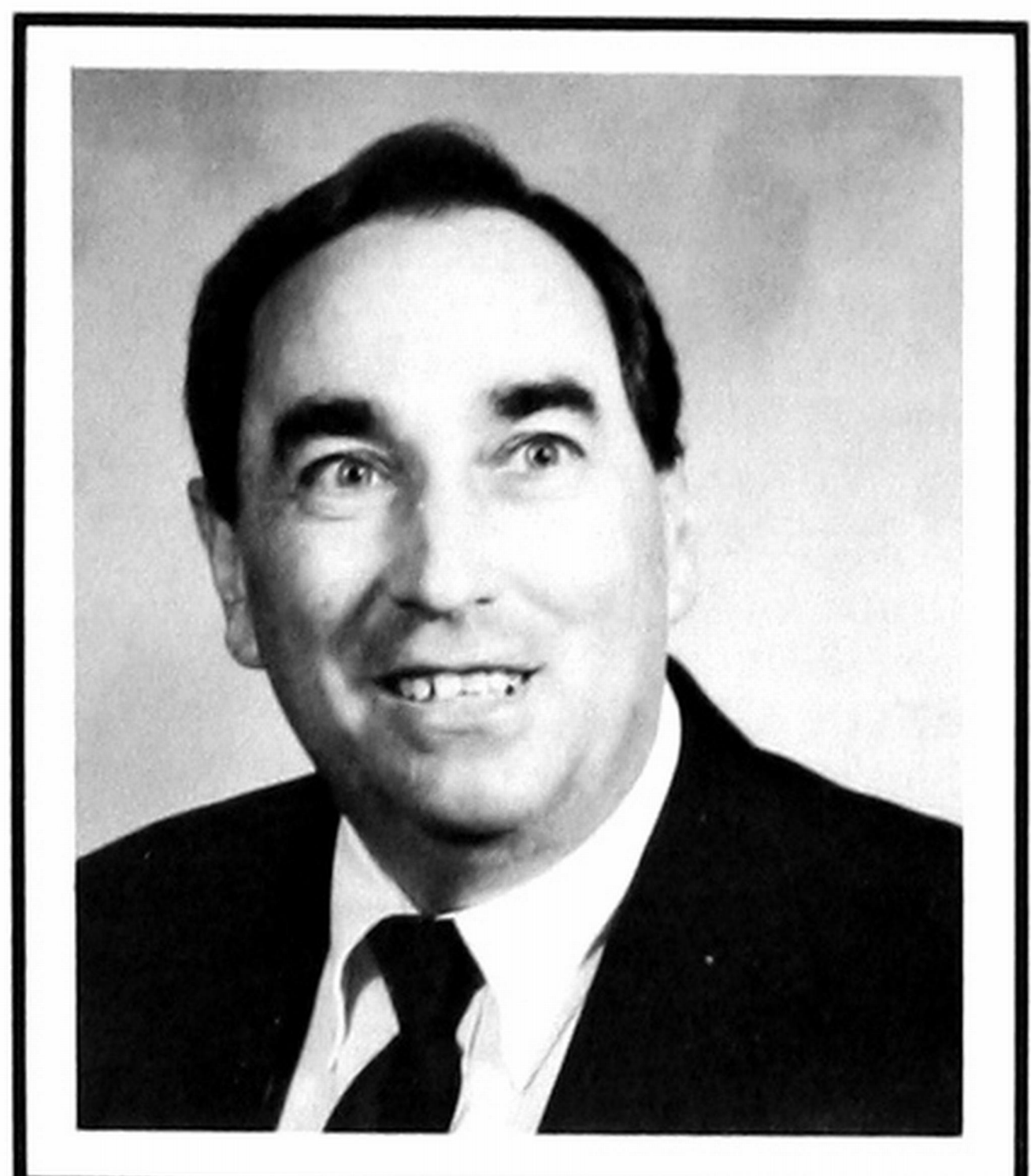
Southwestern at Sayre is vital part of the University. The future of our citizens will continue to be enriched by the quality of education that is available on our branch campus.

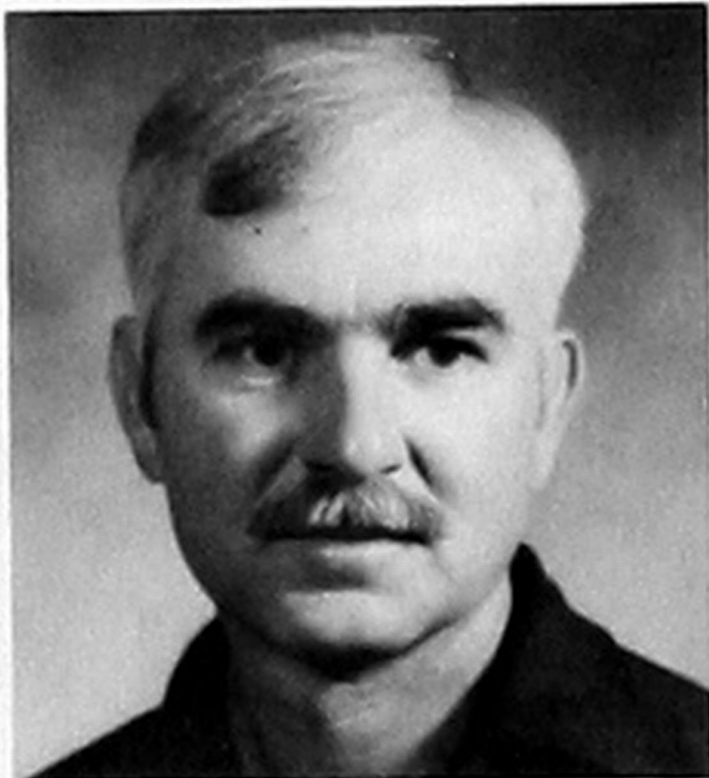
Campus nominating committees and editors of the annual directory have included the names of these students based on their academic achievement, service to the community, leadership in extracurricular activities and potential for continued success.

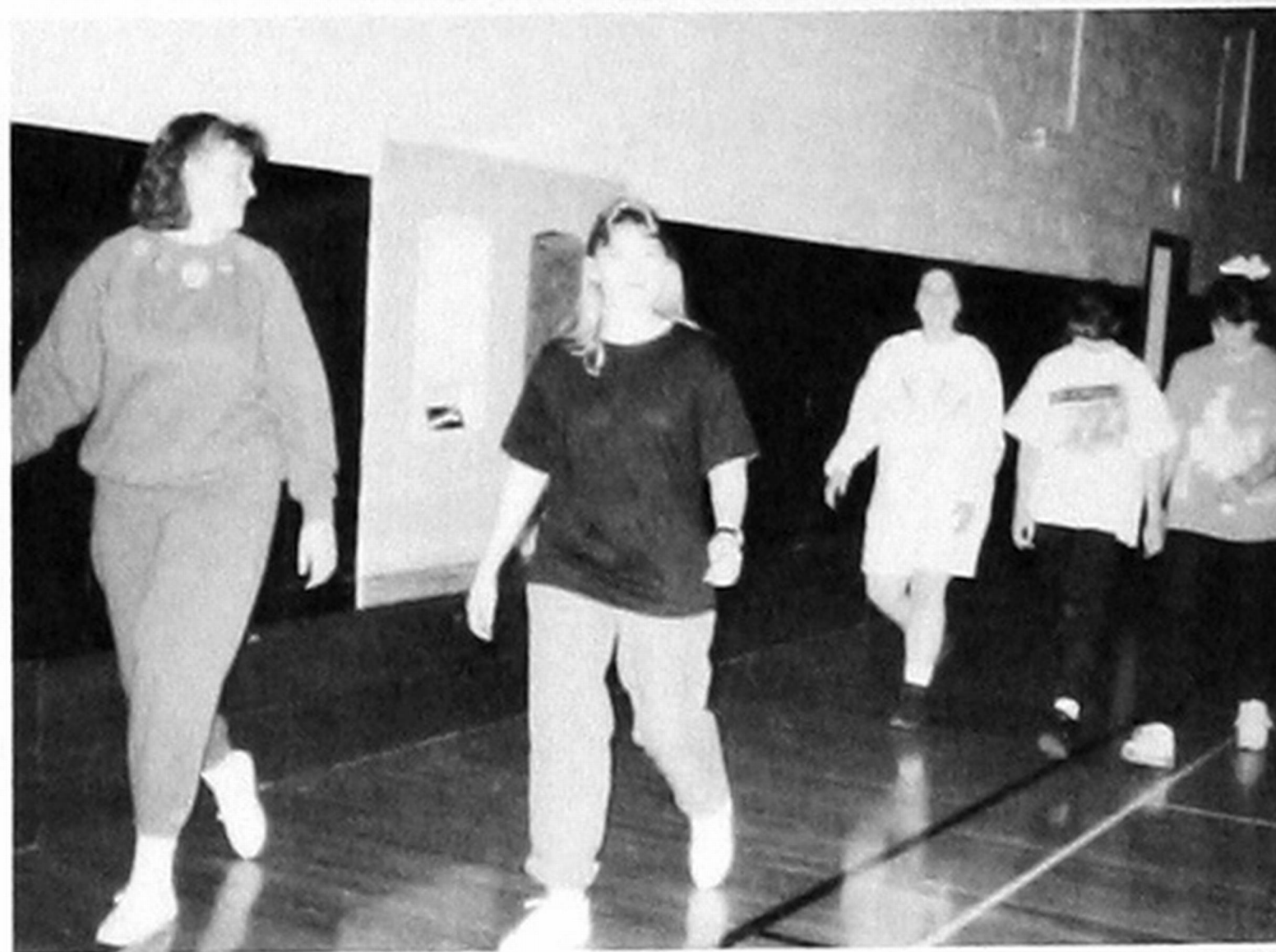

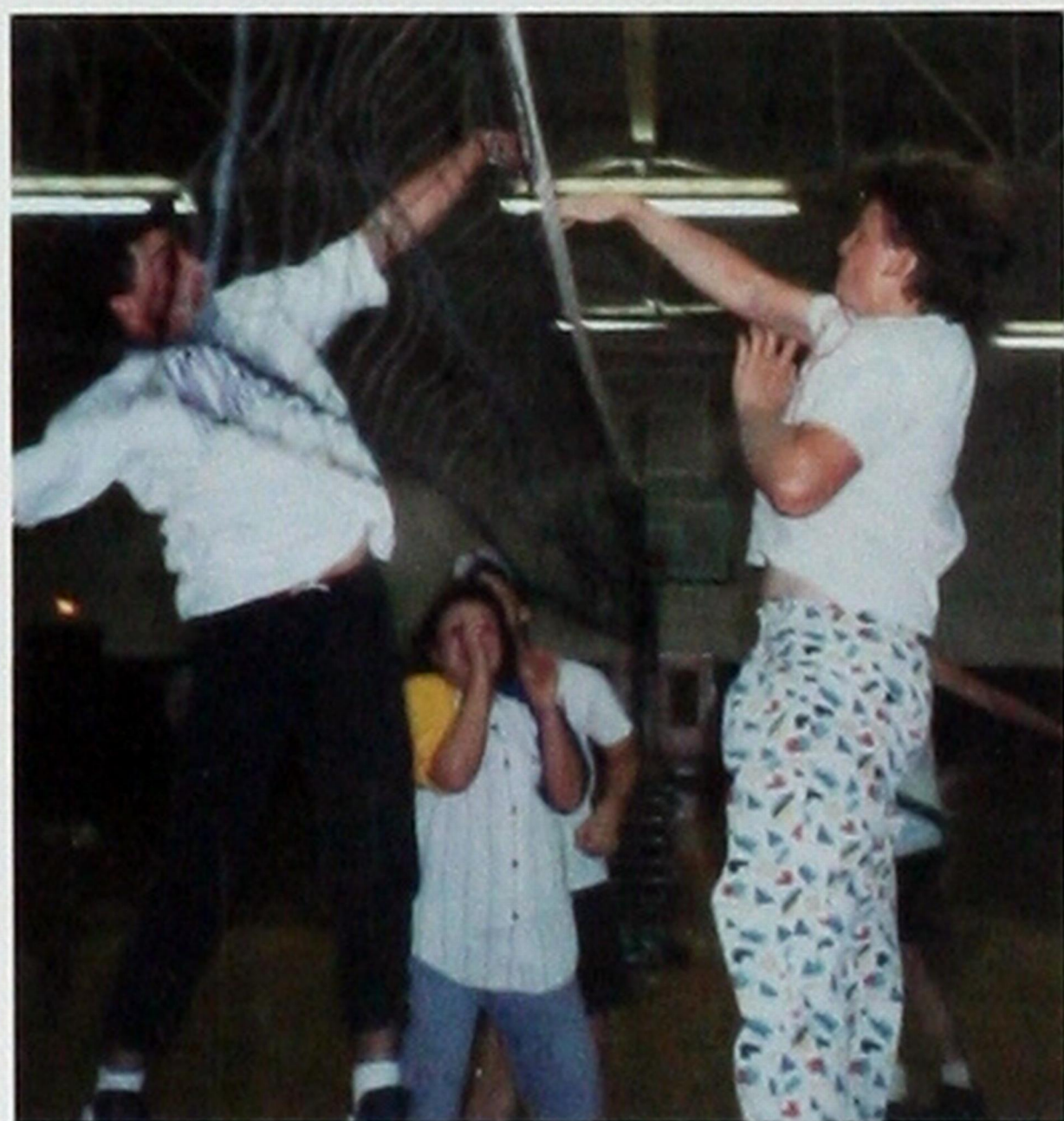

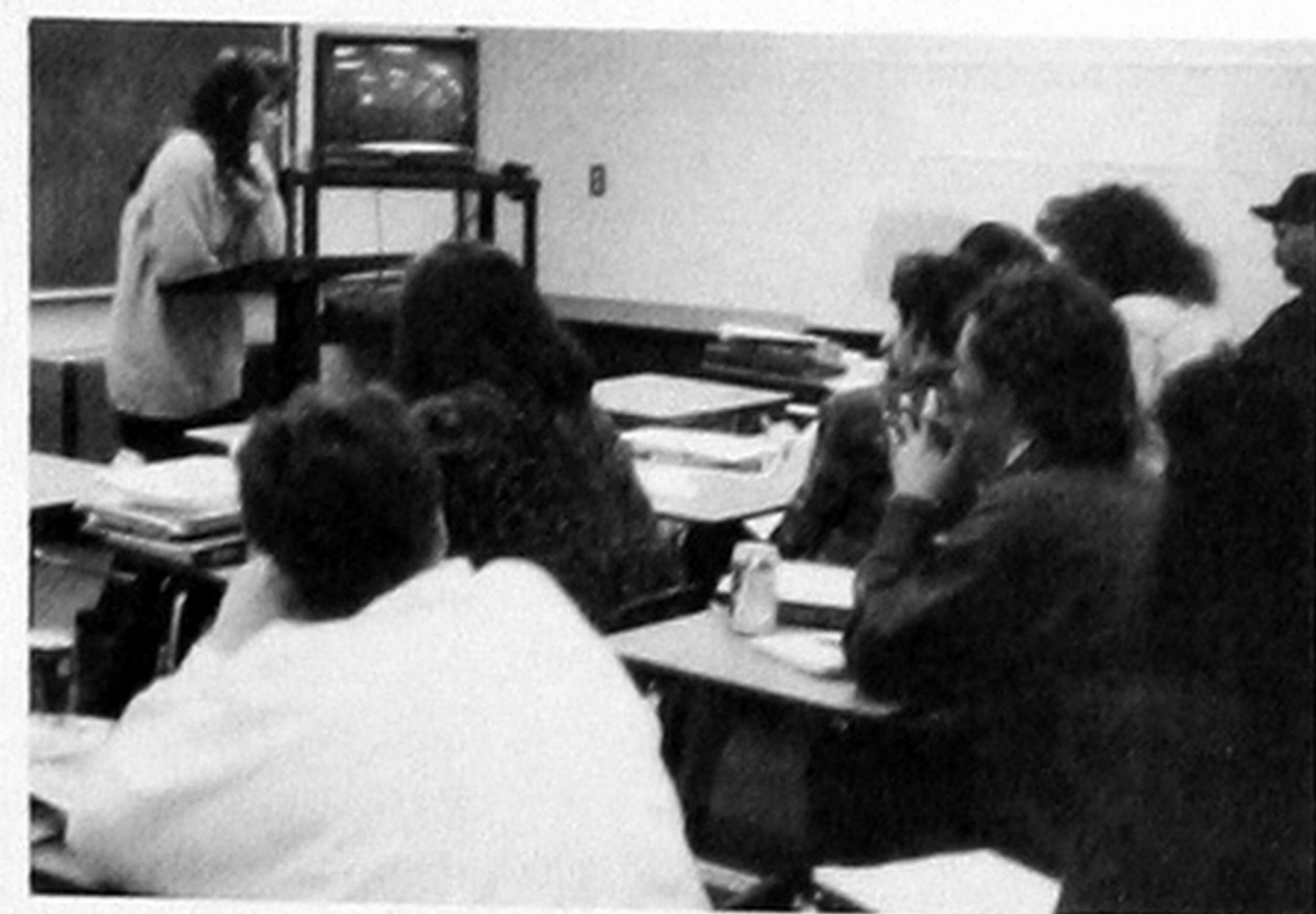
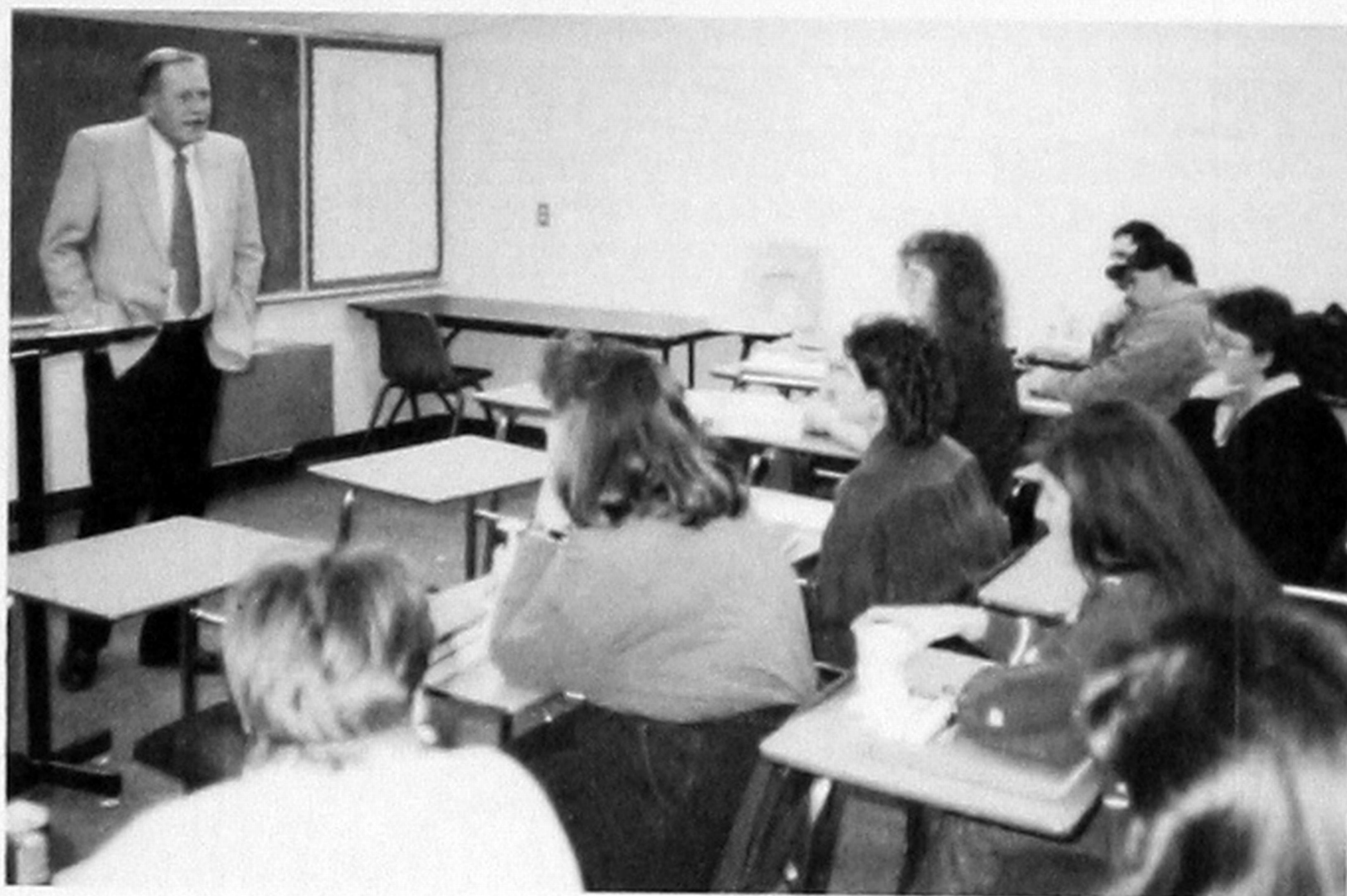


SOEA allows those seeking a major in education to join other teachers, education support personnel, faculty members, and over two thousand other Oklahoma college students in promoting the development of the education profession.

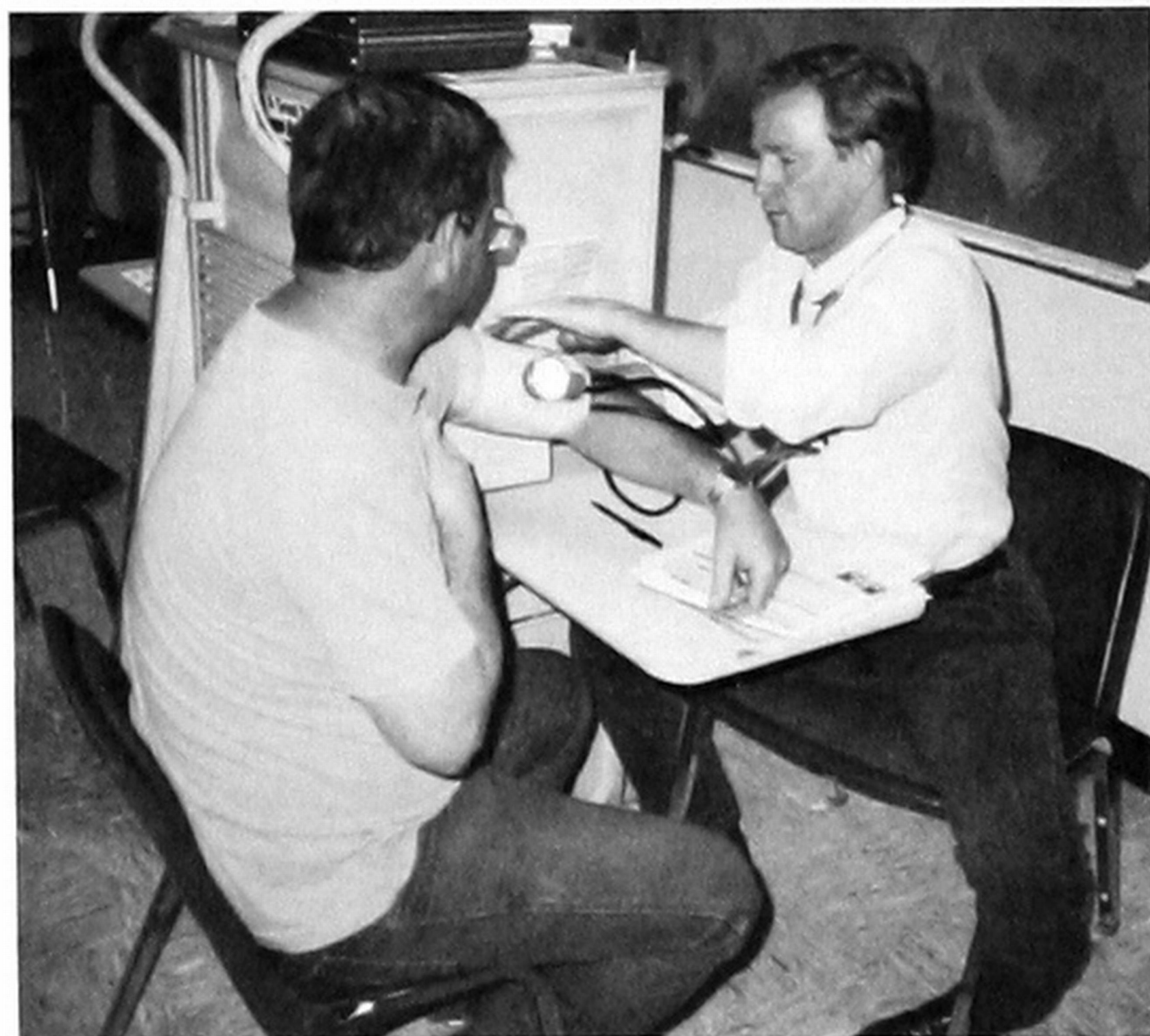

The Health Careers Club was busy again this year with community service projects, attending meetings, sponsoring seminars, and fundraisers.

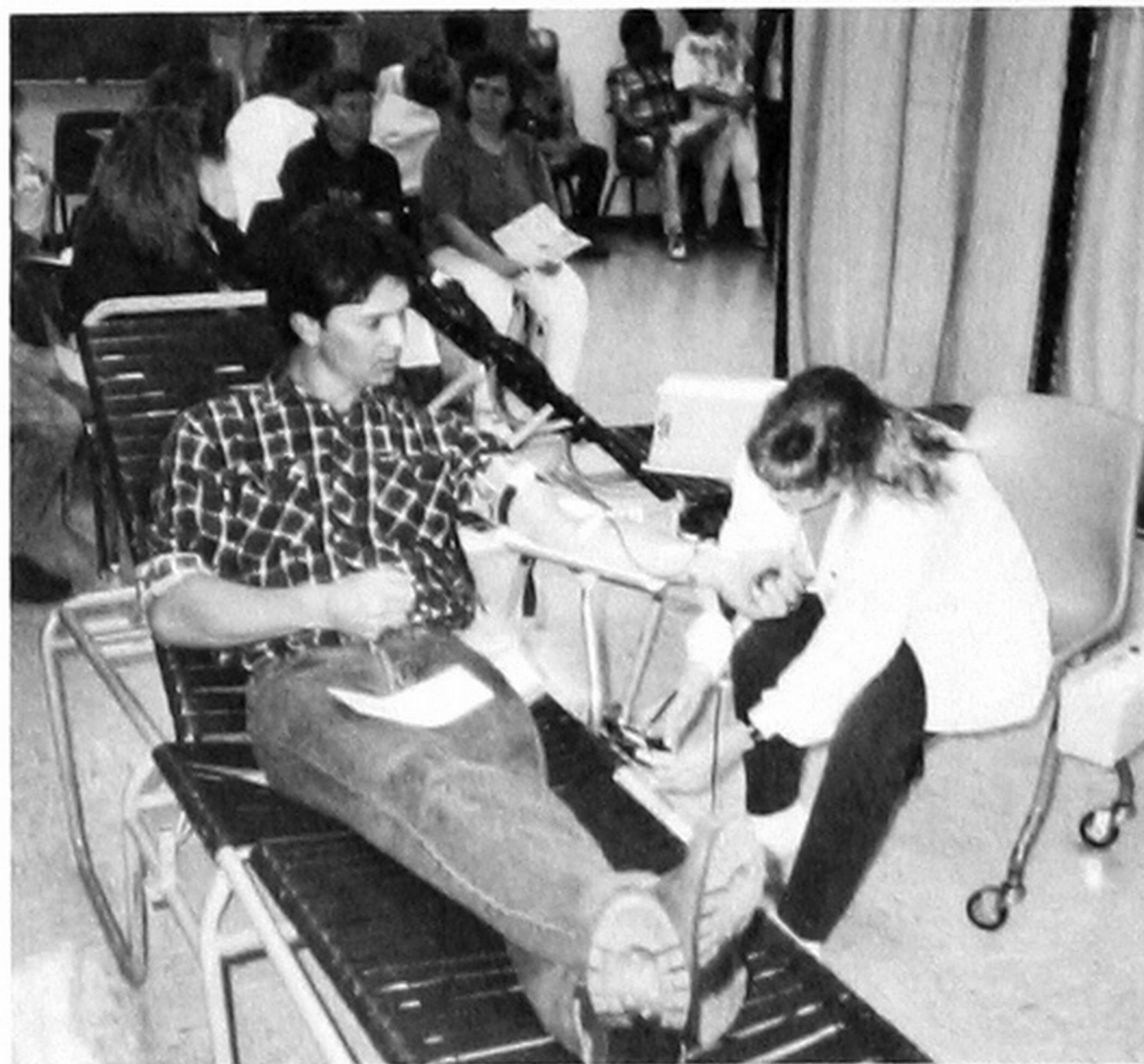
Some of our members helped at the health fairs held in Clinton and Cordell. The students helped with drawing blood and processing patient samples.

The Radiologic Technology program is currently accepting applications from students who wish to be considered for the class which begins in August, 1993.

Students enrolled in the Radiologic Technology program receive formal education in the classroom as well as practical clinical experience. Successful completion of this program leads to an Associate of Applied Science degree and eligibility which qualifies the student as a registered radiologic technologist.

Entrance into the Radiologic Technology program is highly competitive, and it is encouraged that all application material be submitted as early as possible, but no later than April 30, 1993. All applications submitted must include official high school and college transcripts, a documented 4-hour visit to a radiology department, and three letters of reference. Applications will not be considered until all of the required material has been received. Thirty-five applicants will be selected for interviews and will be notified as to the date and time of their interview session. The Radiologic Technology program accepts fifteen students and two alternates each year. All applicants will be notified of their entrance status.

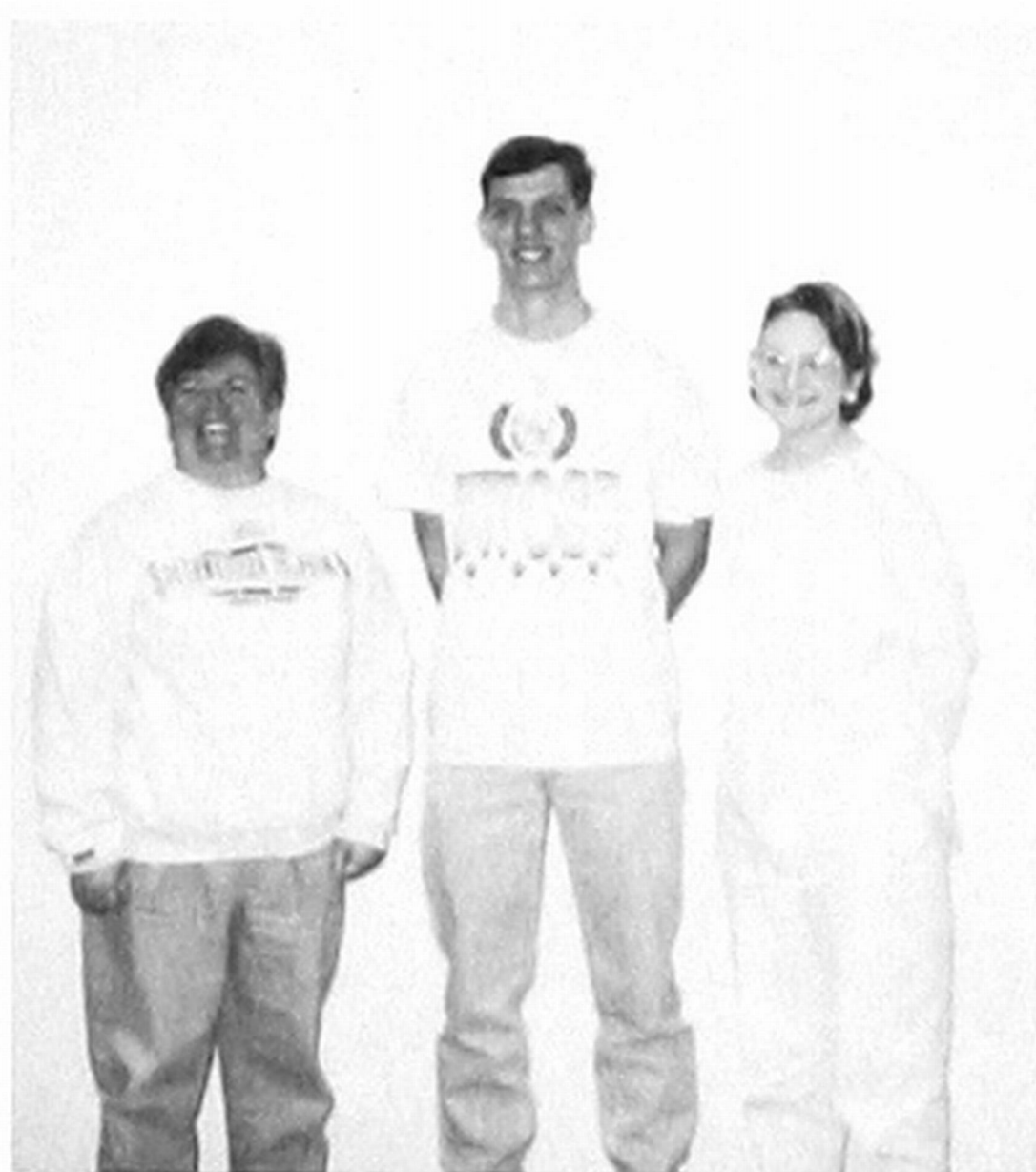


The Baptist Student Union is an interdenominational Christian fellowship of students who are seeking to develop their spiritual lives as they pursue their academic objectives.

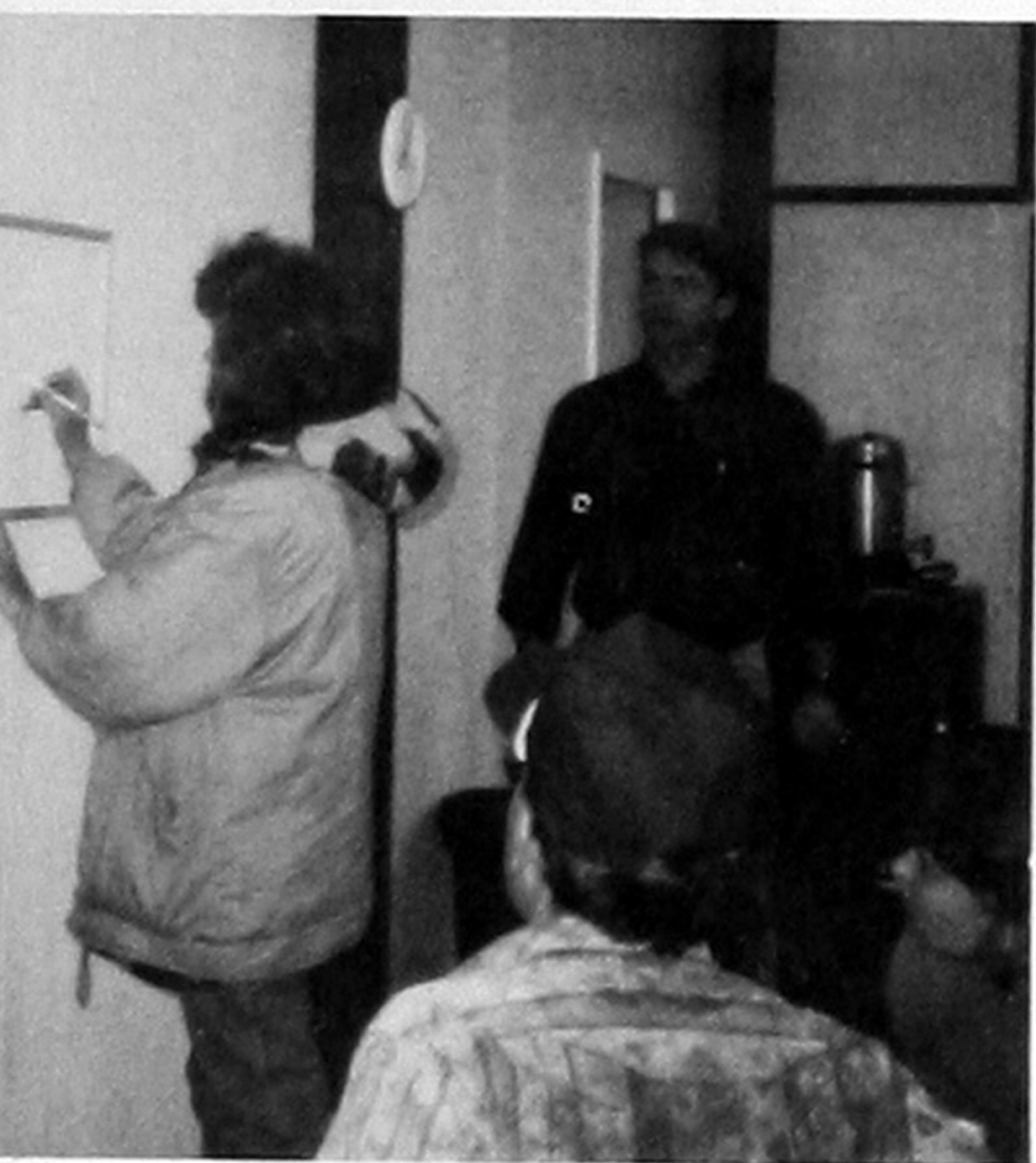
It provides a place where students can come to study, talk, have lunch, or play a game of ping-pong or fooseball in a friendly environment.

Some of the weekly activities that students have an opportunity to participate in are weekend retreats, mission trips, sporting events, and conferences designed for college students and their needs.

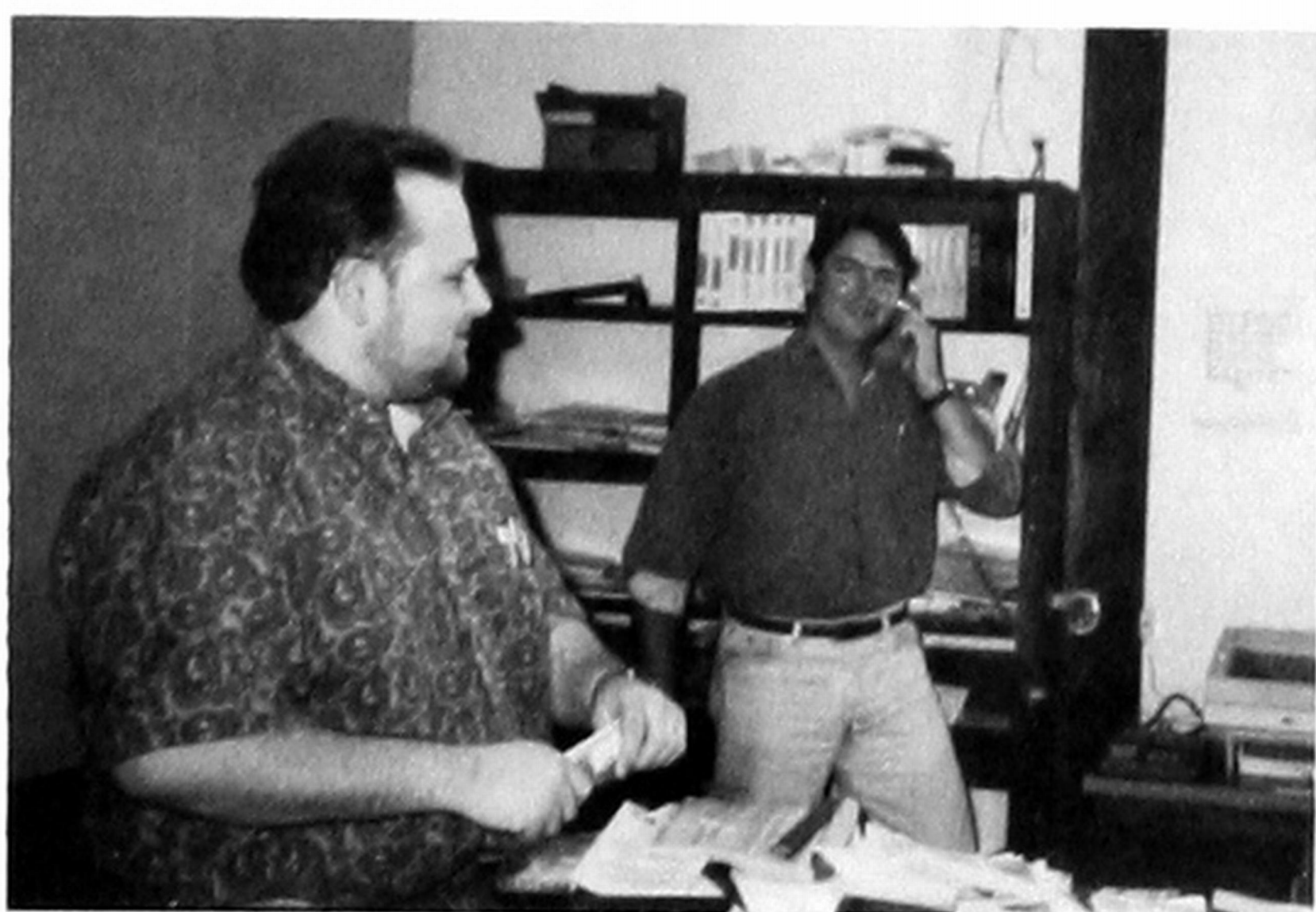

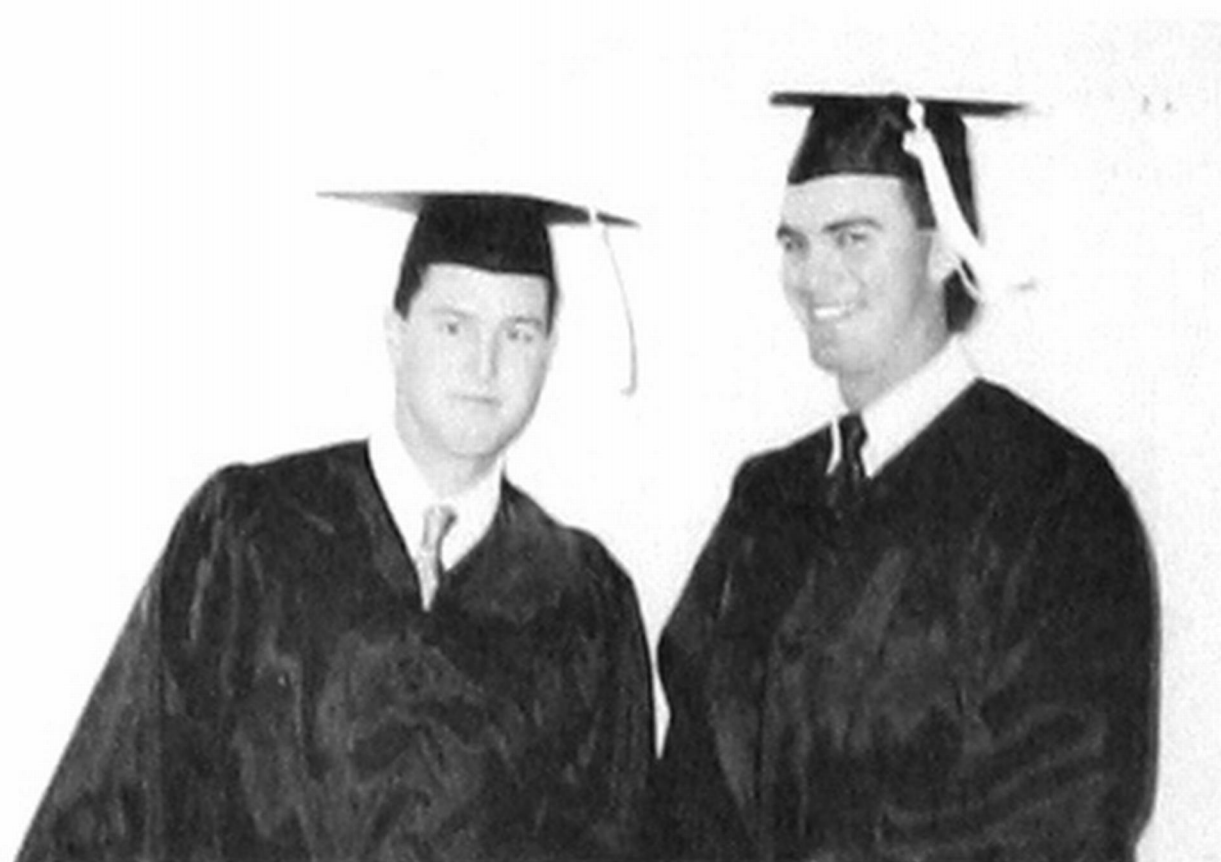
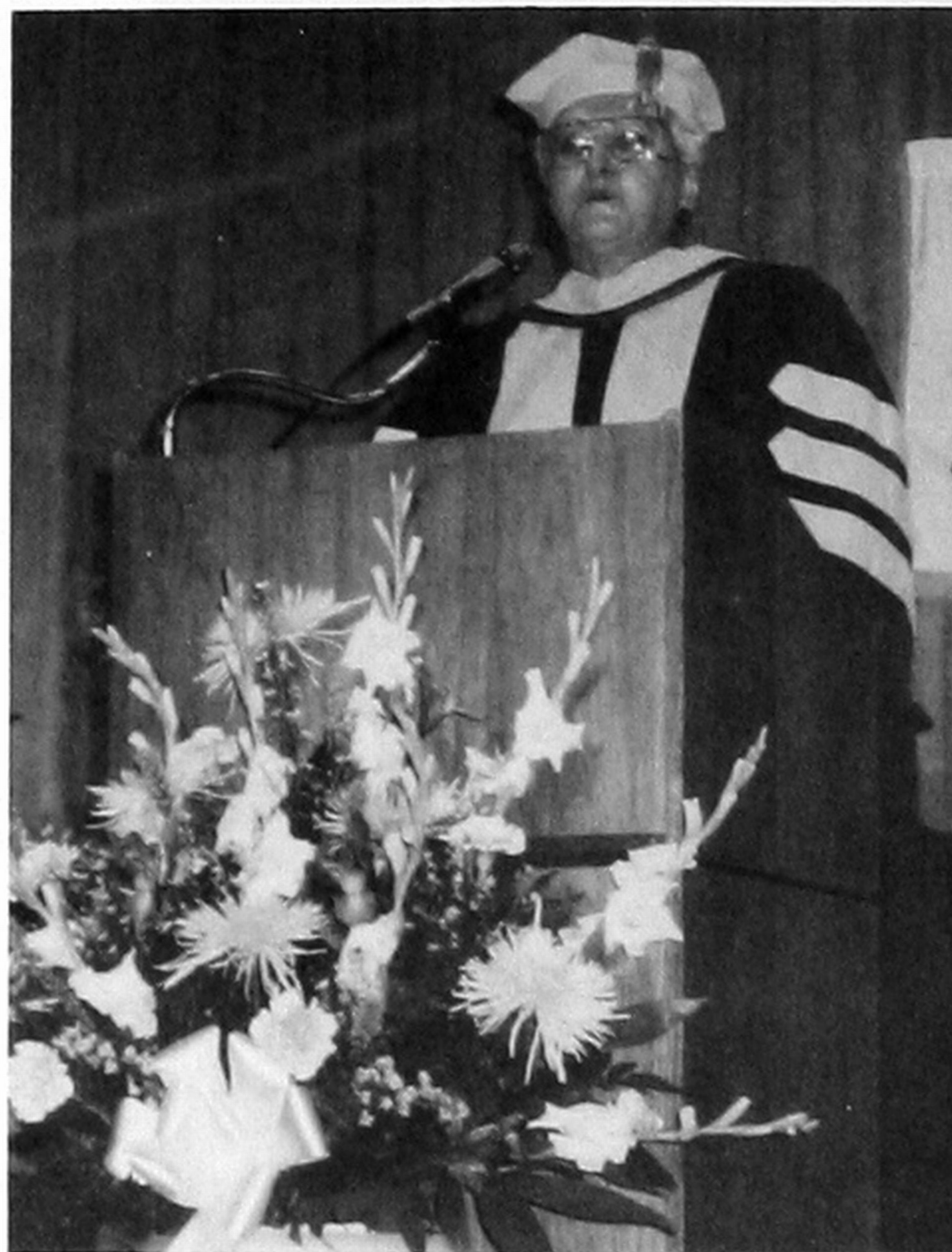
# GRADUATION '93

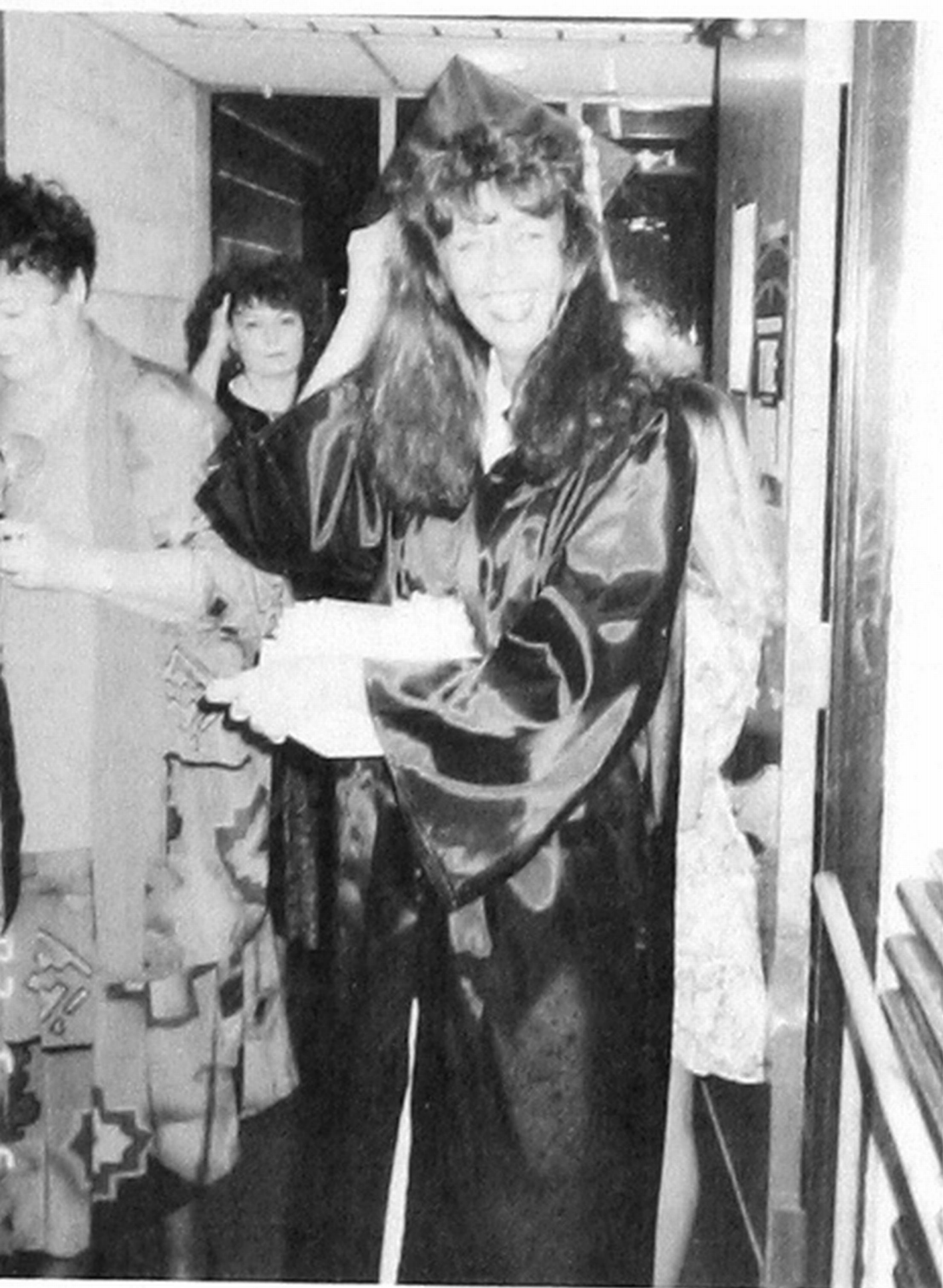
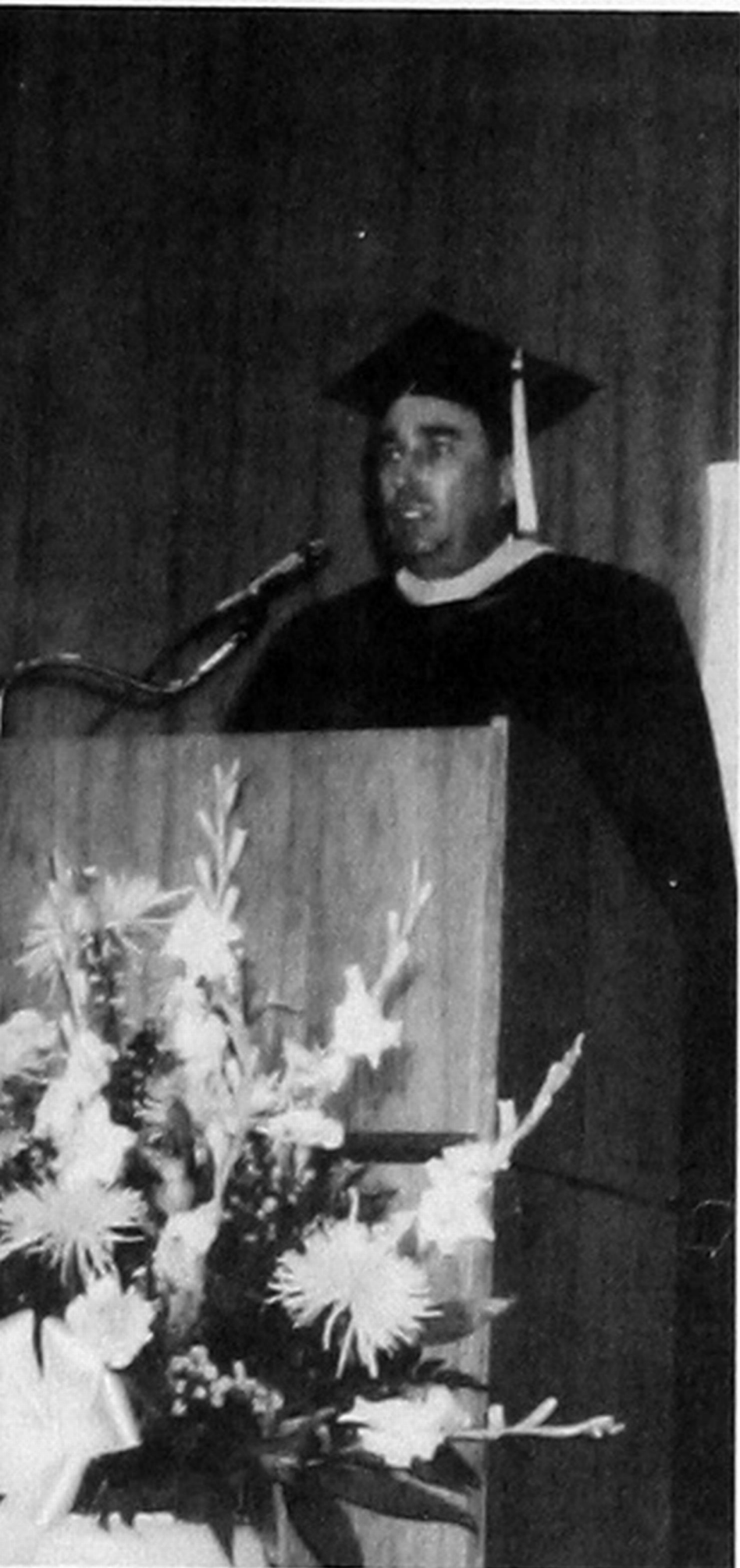
The Convocation Address was given by **Senator Gilmer Capps** and followed by the presentation of Who's Who Awards by **Mrs. Atterberry**.
