## Looking Back: 1950s

- Through the efforts of Dr. W.D. Strother, the School of Pharmacy was accredited by the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE) in January of 1951.
- The American Association of Colleges of Pharmacy accepted the School as a member in August of 1951.
- Alpha Omega Chapter of Phi Delta Chi was the first pharmacy fraternity at SWOSU, being organized in September of 1956.
- In 1956 and 1957, Dr. H.F. Timmons and Dr. Walter L. Dickison were hired. Both men were destined to have long-term impacts on the future of the College.
