## Looking Back: 1960s

- The enrollment in 1960 was 176, and it reached 362 by 1969.
- The Chemistry, Pharmacy, Physics Building was completed in 1963. Through the efforts of Henry Herold, the Pfeiffer Foundation donated matching funds to equip and furnish the building.
- Dr. Walter L. Dickison became the Dean in 1965.
- In 1968, Southwestern began one of the first clinical pharmacy programs in the nation---the program was praised by the American Council on Pharmaceutical Education for its scope and vision.
