

Musical Event Planned in Conjunction with Relay for Life at SWOSU

In a series of new on-campus events, the Southwestern Oklahoma State University Student Government Association and the Collegiate Activities Board are working together to sponsor a free outdoor concert in Weatherford to coincide with this year's American Cancer Society Relay for Life event on April 25.

The event, called "Notapalooza", is not a rival to this year's SWOSUpalooza 9 but will showcase performers that were unable to perform on the main stage of SWOSUpalooza 9 the night before on April 24.

Greg Franklin, recently reelected as SGA president, said the event is one of several in a push to create more activities involving the arts on campus for students.
