

Even though a clinic has been set for August 20 on campus, students and employees are inquiring about getting a FREE shot now. Both Walgreens and Walmart in Weatherford offer walk-in service but prefer appointments. Online appointments can be made at any Walgreens and Walmart in the state, but they might require appointments.
