

SWOSU Convocation Set for May 13

Approximately 840 Southwestern Oklahoma State University students are eligible to walk through the university's convocation at 10 a.m. on Saturday, May 13, at Milam Stadium in Weatherford.

Students who completed or will complete bachelor's, master's or doctoral degrees after the 2005 fall, 2006 spring, 2006 summer and 2006 fall semesters are eligible to participate in the ceremony.

An informal reception will be held in the Wellness Center from 8 to 9:30 a.m. Graduates, parents and friends are welcome to relax and visit.

If convocation cannot be held at Milam Stadium because of inclement weather, four separate exercises will be held in two different buildings on the SWOSU campus. An announcement to use the alternative plan will be made on local radio stations.

- 1:30 p.m.-College of Professional & Graduate Studies-Rankin Williams Fieldhouse (Includes School of Behavioral Sciences and Education, School of Allied Health and School of Nursing)
- 3:15 p.m.-School of Professional & Graduate Studies-Rankin Williams Fieldhouse (Includes School of Business, School of Computer Science & Technology and Graduate Studies—Master's Degrees.

If the alternative plan is used, the Wellness Center will be open from 8 a.m. until 3:15 p.m. to provide coffee and a place for family and friends to gather while waiting for the appropriate ceremony.

John W. Aaron of Marble Falls, Texas, and Benny J. Hill of Sante Fe, N.M., will be inducted into the SWOSU Distinguished Alumni Hall of Fame and will be the featured speakers at this year's SWOSU Convocation.
