Fred Alsberg, an assistant professor in the Southwestern Oklahoma State University Department of Language Arts, has recently published or had accepted for publication six of his poems.

"Humility" will be appearing in Pennine Ink, a Great Britain publication. "Beachcomber," "Congratulations," and "Bedtime" will be appearing in Talking River, an Idaho literary magazine. An interview with Alsberg and a selection of his poems will be published in the Spring/Summer issue of Westview, Southwestern Oklahoma State University's literary magazine.

He will also be reading from his work in Albuquerque this February.

"Oklahoma Windscape" appeared in the May/June 2005 issue of Oklahoma Today, and "Beginning the Modern-day Odyssey" appeared in a recent issue of Louisiana Review.

Alsberg teaches creative writing, literature and composition classes at SWOSU and advises majors in the "English: Writing Emphasis" major.
