Items that will be collected include:

- clothing, household items, carpet, linens, small appliances, furniture, etc.
- cardboard, cereal boxes, aluminum, paper, plastics #1 and #2

The Great American Cleanup is the nation's largest annual cleanup, beautification, and community improvement program.
