Southwestern Oklahoma State University continues to be a popular choice for incoming freshmen as 754 high school seniors have enrolled for the 2010 fall semester at SWOSU as part of the New Student Orientation Program on the Weatherford campus.

Todd Boyd, director of admissions and recruitment, said freshmen enrollment continues to run significantly higher than at the same time in 2009.

"People continue to select SWOSU as their college choice," Boyd said. Each of the enrollment sessions offers students the chance to meet current SWOSU students and new freshmen, visit and enroll with a faculty advisor within the major they have selected, and get all their questions answered.
