

Mary's Wedding Being Staged November 11-14 at SWOSU

Southwestern Oklahoma State University's Department of Art, Communication and Theatre will soon open its next theatre production—*Mary's Wedding*.

The show, set during World War I, is purposefully set to open on November 11 to commemorate Veteran's Day. The production runs November 11, 13 and 14 at 7:30 p.m. and November 12 at 2 p.m. in the SWOSU Hilltop Theatre on the Weatherford campus.

Mary's Wedding, by Stephen Massicotte, is a beautifully written play, according to director Steve Strickler. On the night before her wedding, Mary dreams of a thunderstorm, during which she unexpectedly meets Charlie sheltering in a barn beside his horse. With innocence and humor, the two discover a charming first love. But the year is 1914, and the world is collapsing into a brutal war. It is an epic, unforgettable story of love, hope and survival.
