

Weatherford Native to Talk Wednesday about Research Experiences

Weatherford native Tyler Shadid, who is currently working on his master's degree in microbiology, will present a talk on his undergraduate research experiences and his current graduate research this Wednesday, October 23, on the Southwestern Oklahoma State University campus.

Shadid, a SWOSU alum, will talk at 4 p.m. in Room 212 of the Old Science Building. The title of his talk is: *Cultivating the scientific mind: experiences in undergraduate and graduate research.*

He has been awarded several fellowships and has been involved in three undergraduate research projects supported by the National Science Foundation.
